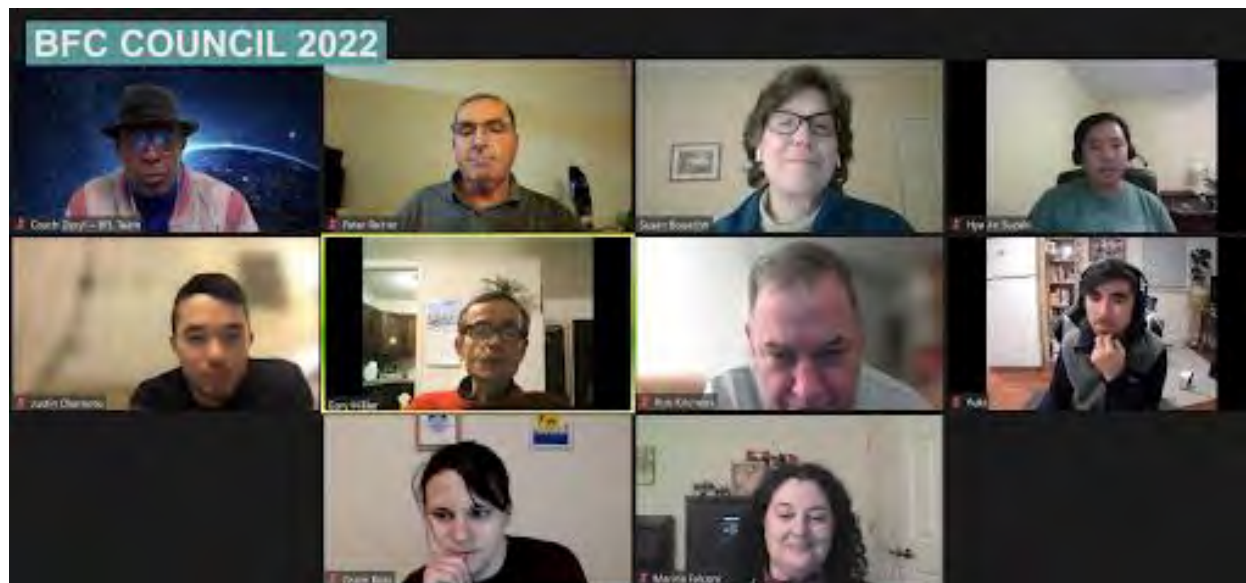


Belvedere Family Church: Council Corner: News from 1/19/22 Council Meeting
