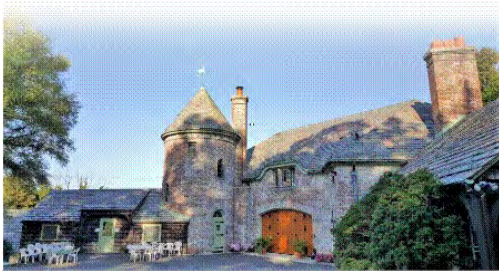

No registration is guaranteed until fee is paid in full. We reserve the right to delete any registration that is not paid for by October 4. After October 4, all fees must be paid at the time of registration.

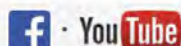

Refunds

A refund fee is necessary due to transaction costs and commitments made by the camp based on the number of attendees. We try to keep it as low as possible to accommodate guests with extenuating circumstances that require them to withdraw from camp.

If notified by email at registrar@shehaquafamily.org up to 12 days before the registered program starts, we will issue a refund minus a 5% cancellation fee. If notified up to 2 days before the registered program starts, we will issue a refund minus a 35% cancellation fee. Instead of a refund, we also offer 100% credit towards future Shehaqua programs.

Camp Shehaqua is run entirely by volunteers! This helps us keep costs low, and more importantly gives everyone an opportunity to be a part of creating the experience as a community. 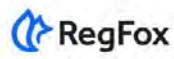
