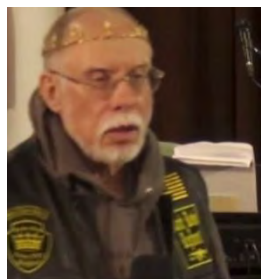

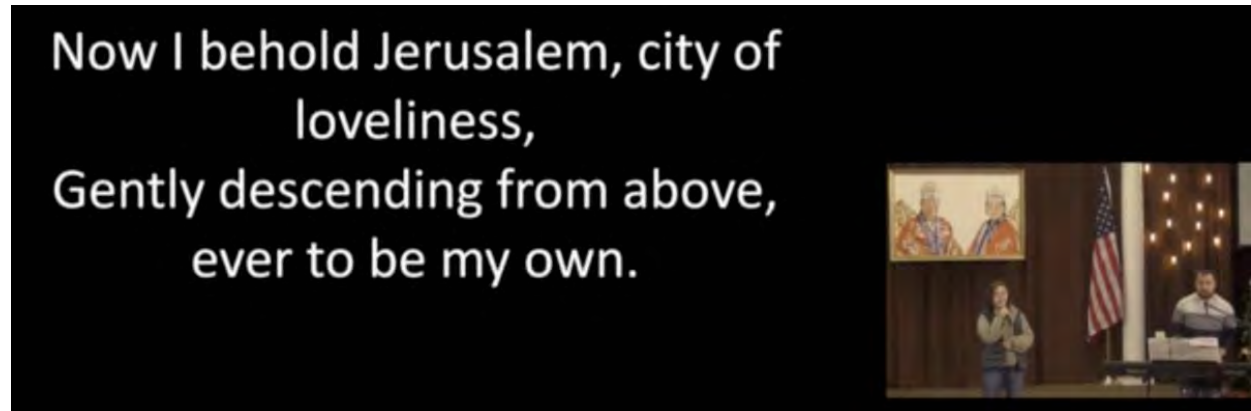
Hello,

Since technical difficulties cut short the remote broadcast from Tennessee, the Sunday sermon was given by Assistant Pastor Kyle Toffey. Kyle spoke about the passage in Genesis 22, which tells the account of Abraham's readiness to sacrifice Isaac and the prolongation of the providence through the three generations of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob. In his willingness to sacrifice even his own son, Abraham showed he loved God more than anything. Isaac realized that he was to be sacrificed, but still trusted his father. When the Bible states that "God will provide the sacrifice," it means that He has found someone willing to give their life to accomplish His will. As True Father taught and showed us, we should aspire to have that type of faith and love.



Similarly, the failure of Hak Ja Han has led to the prolongation of True Father's course to be accomplished through the 3 Generation Kingships. Hyung Jin Nim himself was shocked to be anointed by his father in 2009. From that moment on, his schedule was not his own. True Father would suddenly call him and ask him to change his plans. True Father was so happy at his son's willingness to respond without question.

Hyung Jin Nim was happiest when he could take the crown off of his head. Many urged him to give it to his oldest brother, but he wanted to obey his father's desire.



His Father's passing was followed by his mother's betrayal, with many urging him to just follow her rewrite of True Father's words.
