Living a Life of Prayer and Absolute Faith



And rising very early in the morning, while it was still dark, he departed and went out to a desolate place, and there he prayed. **Mark 1:35**

Do you think I made a commitment to God that I would never change, not for fifty years or the rest of my life? 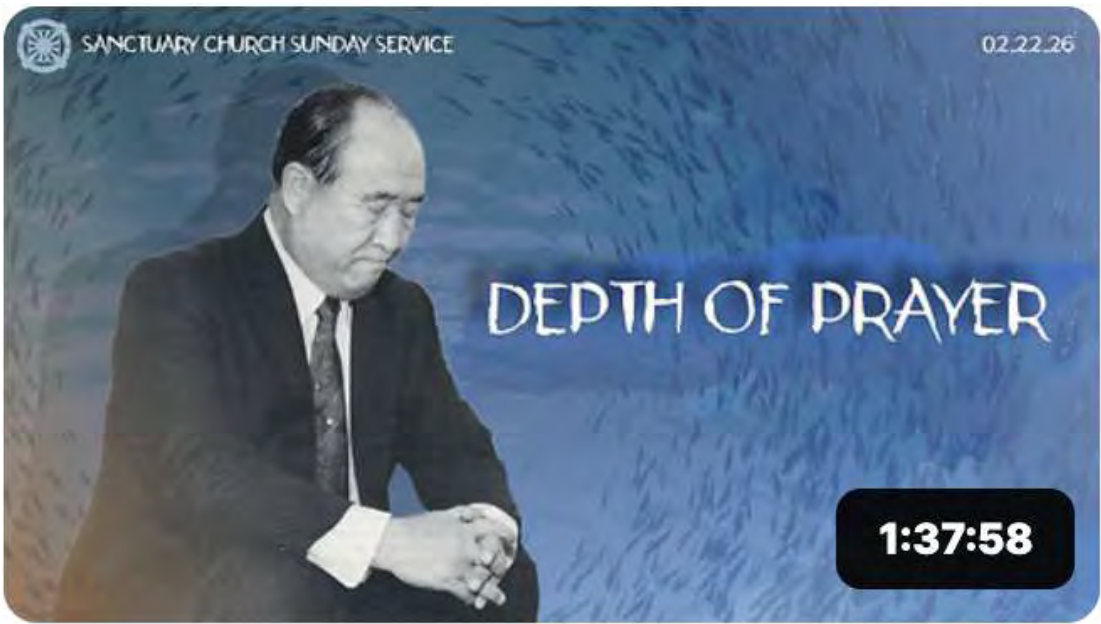
Sun Myung Moon, "The Importance Of Prayer," April 15, 1979

Thornhill TN Sanctuary pastor Regis Hanna, who just returned from Taiwan after 43 hours of travel, read Hyung Jin Nim's Midnight Prayer in which he thanked God for opening the path for the liberation of China and of Jeong Ju. He also showed this year's motto, **"The Liberation of True Parents' Homeland and the Eternal Reign of Peace."**

Regis explained that the lyrics of the songs of King Bullethead were prayers that were heard by patriots at the Trump rallies. The Freedom Festivals were the foundation for the 2nd King's song/prayer at Mar a Lago. Trump is anointed to not only make America great but to expose and reject Communism in the U.S. and around the world.

The 2nd King was absolutely loyal to True Father. We in the remnant often didn't understand everything he was doing, but we played our part. We are all sinners. Satan has the password to our "bank account." Christ pays off the debt. "REPENT for the Kingdom of Heaven is at hand! Jesus and Father have paid the price through shedding their blood. It's essential to understand our real position.

Then Gregg Noll spoke. What did Jesus say about prayer? As stated in Matthew 6:5-6, pray privately and not for show. True Father liked to go out to the sea, to pray in private.

Gregg explained that he and Elke often took their family out to hike in nature. Gregg likes to pray early in the morning to be alone with God. Just like he enjoyed spending time with his son Justin to talk about plans and challenges in their days.

Gregg has fond memories of going to hear Father speak at Belvedere. One time Gregg was sitting in the front row. Father grabbed his tie and asked "what is your name?" Gregg said, "Gregg." Then Father said, "Great!" it was a moving experience for him. Father spoke about how close God is to us: "Your beating heart "why don't you feel your heart? It's because you are one. It is because there is balance. This is not a conceptual thing. It's a fact." Father said that God is so close, there is no separation."



True God's Day Midnight Prayer w/ English Translation

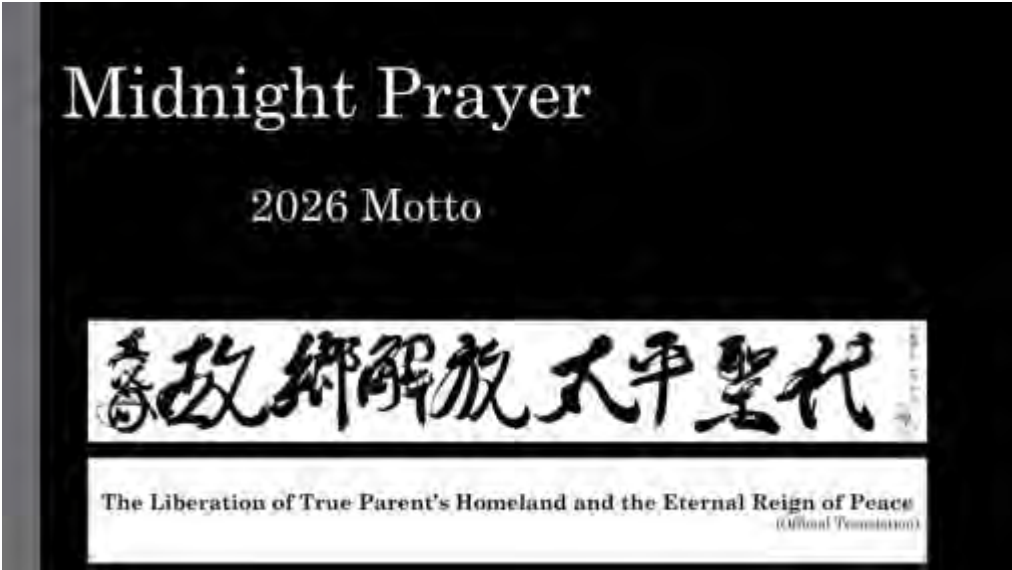
Jesus said, "Father, forgive them for they know not what they do." He forgave those who didn't deserve it. Neither do we. Father repeatedly forgave those who betrayed him. Several forgiveness ceremonies were conducted. Satan cannot do this. This is the way to separate from Satan. Gregg showed a photo of True Father embracing Kim Il Sung. In a police state like North Korea, no one ever dared to hug Kim Il Sung. Father set the gold standard.

Here are other points Gregg spoke about:

3. Pray non-stop. Jesus taught us to repeatedly seek God in prayer.
4. Living a life of prayer. Sharing and reporting about your life to God. Prayers cannot be heard without commitment.

Gregg had a lot of pain last year from sciatic nerve in his back and hands. He can declare that one year later he was healed. His back pain is gone!

5. Pray BIG! God plugs his ears when he hears small prayers. But when you pray for His Kingdom to come, his ears pick up, as he explained in his speech in 1979 on "The Importance of Prayer."

Gregg and others were in Russia after the Soviet Union dissolved in 1991. He spent 3 years teaching Divine Principle there. Now the 2nd King is asking us to pray for brothers and sisters in China. The Communist world starts to crumble.

6. Absolute FAITH- whatever you ask in prayer, have conviction that your prayers will be answered. Gregg's first big church event was mobilizing for Washington Monument. Within a short time, 300,000 people participated. The central figures of God's providence, Noah, Abraham, Moses, Jesus all had to display absolute faith.

Hyung Jin Nim and Kook Jin Nim had to exercise Absolute Faith in separating from the Han mother and being guided in America. Gregg, Lowell, Hunno were with the 2nd King bush crafting in the dead of winter. After that, he gave the "Breaking the Silence" speech.

Did Jesus have a successful remnant praying in the Garden of Gethsemane? No. Did Father find fervent Christians to support his work? No, he had to find the 2nd or 3rd level remnant, us. At the end of his life, he declared that "everything has been completed."

Through the 2nd King's faith, he was able to uplift Father.

The Ontology of Sun Myung Moon

The belief that Sun Myung Moon is the returning Messiah has been the central tenet in Unification theology. Unificationists have traditionally believed that Rev. Moon was born without original sin, embodied the same heart as Jesus Christ in loving and forgiving his enemies, and fulfilled the original ideal of creation by establishing the position of True Parents.

However, beginning with the removal of the Eight Great Textbooks by FFWPU in 2013, and the emergence of the "Only Begotten Daughter" theology in the mid-2010s, the core doctrine taught by leaders of FFWPU (now HPHC) has been radically altered.

The common base of shared beliefs and traditions which kept us connected as one family has been broken. Our raison d'etre for meeting to discuss "religious matters" is in question because we are no longer united in our understanding of Sun Myung Moon's essential identity. What can we realistically hope to achieve by discussing the Six Marys, physical salvation, or the meaning of Cheon Il Guk if we hold substantially different views about the very person who gave rise to these concepts?

It is interesting to note that less than twenty years after Reverend Moon's passing, we are already headlong into the debate regarding his ontological status. Reverend Moon provides the context for understanding the nature of Jesus by comparing him to the original Adam:

"Adam, had he realized the ideal of perfection symbolized by the tree of life in the Garden of Eden, and Jesus, symbolized by the tree of life in the Book of Revelation, would be identical in the sense of having realized the goal of creation. As such, they would have equal value." (Exposition of Divine Principle p.166)

In the Exposition of Divine Principle, Jesus is described as a man who has completed the purpose of creation, however he is not the Creator Himself. Rev. Moon described Jesus as the first man of perfection ever to walk the earth, and that he came to restore the true relationship between God and man. But, as he clarified in his 1973 speech "God's Hope for Man": "After Jesus' crucifixion, Christianity made him into God. This is why the gap between God and man has never been bridged. Jesus is a man in whom God is incarnate. But he is not God Himself." Rev. Moon taught that God does not desire Jesus alone as His son; rather, God wishes for all humanity to proclaim, "I am in the Father, and the Father is in me." He strongly encouraged us to understand that this represents the attainable destiny of every person,

In his later years, however, Rev. Moon introduced new terminology regarding the ontology of God and Christ: "God of Night "and "God of Day." Rather than viewing his later teachings as contradictory to his earlier guidance, I believe that he continued to provide deeper clarification regarding the nature of 1st /2nd /3rd Adam as time progressed.
