I was happy to hear Dr. Ki Hoon Kim speak last week at a gathering just below the UTS campus in NYC about Peter Kassig, the former American Army Ranger who volunteered to return to the Middle East, this time as an aid worker serving Syrian refugees. He disappeared more than a year ago at a checkpoint in northeastern Syria while delivering medical supplies. He was beheaded by Islamic State militants in mid November.

The reasons for the horrific events unfolding in the Middle East would lead to a long discussion, but I'm sure UTS' founder, Rev. Sun Myung Moon, would agree that an American soldier who returns to the battlefield, not to fight, but to serve suffering refugees



deserves our greatest respect. And since he was kidnapped and martyred while doing so, surely he can be located in the highest realms of the spirit world.

To me Peter Kassig represents the best of the American spirit of service that inspired Rev. Moon to come to the U.S. more than 40 years ago. America has something invaluable to offer the world, and I hope that American Unificationists do not lose sight of this.
