In his sermon on the "Kingdom of the Rod of Iron," Hyung Jin Nim explained that things are developing fast, but when God opens up the Red Sea you have to just go!

In contrast to a kingdom, democracy always ends with the majority voting for the state to redistribute resources by forcibly taking wealth from others, leading to its demise within 2-3 centuries.

We have to understand True Father's culture. When not at official meetings, True Father liked to be around fishermen and hunters, working class people who often carried weapons, real patriots ready to defend America. In Matt 4:17 -22 it describes how Jesus went to the Sea of Galilee and found two "water hunters" (fishermen). Hunters and fishermen deal with life and death. They have to take life to survive and tend to be more conservative. Sports Father was involved with involved life and death.



The FFWPU became elitist. "Oh, how exciting that I am in the UN building!" Such elitists are far from Father's involvement with an often cold, smelly, slimy life of fishing. Especially the women, including the Han mother. What if she had embraced fishing and hunting? This is the King of Kings culture. We have to embrace that lifestyle, too. Hyung Jin Nim is proud of Yeonah Nim because even though outdoor survival training is not her favorite, she challenged herself by sleeping outside in subzero temperature.

The rule of the rod of iron is not a scary place, except for bad people. Liberals trying to solve these problems end up creating hell on earth in such areas of Chicago and Detroit where bad guys can do whatever they want including murders, rapes, thefts, etc. When good people have weapons and responsibility, criminals will learn that "grandma" has armed defense and will quickly learn not to go there. Hyung Jin Nim concluded by giving real-life examples of average Americans with firearms who saved many lives such as a 34 year old woman who was able to defend her life against 5 men breaking into her house and an 80 year-old grandpa who stopped an armed man who came into a restaurant and shot a father/CEO in the head.
