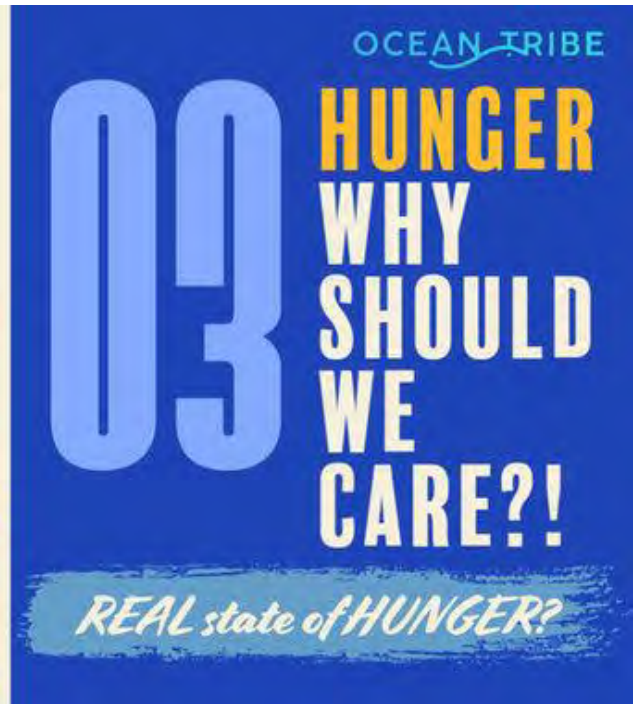



We would like to announce that we will hold a conference called “Ocean Summit 2022” in Gloucester, MA on August 6th (Saturday, also connected with ZOOM), in order to discuss and strategize Ocean Providence activities in the United States.

Introduction

The world and our youths face tremendous adversities. According to the United Nations’ SDG 2019 Report, the global malnourished population has been increasing since 2015¹ but had further worsened by the COVID-19 Pandemic. The war in Ukraine and the global inflation are also aggravating the problem. While various problems grow on the global stage, our children are faced with the escalating gender problem in schools and an opioid epidemic in our communities. According to recent reports, about 21 percent of Generation Z in the United States identify themselves as LGBTQ². And the number of drug-related deaths in the United States is at an all-time high³. CDC also announced that in 2019, 18.8% of high school students seriously considered attempting suicide and 8.9% actually attempted suicide⁴.

True Parents officially started the Ocean Providence in the United States on August 1st, 1974, atop New Hope. Since then, many of our older members had been trained spiritually, mentally, and physically by True Parents on the ocean, in order to be leaders in this era and to create a global foundation of marine and tourism industries to ultimately solve the global starvation problem to create a truly peaceful world. True Father continued to train members through the

Purpose

The following are the purposes of the Ocean Summit 2022.

1. Identifying the challenges faced by Ocean Providence in the United States. Ocean Challenge, Ocean Tribe, businesses, and other select participants will report their activities and discuss what the challenges are within this meeting.
2. Clarifying the goals of the Ocean Tribe / Ocean Challenge activities. For now, here is what the Ocean Tribe SR1 proposes:

a. Train youths in the ocean to inherit the vision of Ocean Providence.

The importance of the Ocean Providence is best relayed to the youth through experiences in the ocean through Ocean Challenge and Ocean Tribe activities. In the ocean, the youth can grow spiritually, mentally, and physically, to be ready to work in the ocean providence.

b. Guide youths to inherit or start ocean-related businesses/projects per TP's vision.

The vision of Ocean Providence is centered on marine businesses as well as hobby tourism businesses. By creating a global business network of supply chain from fishery to restaurants, True Parents planned to establish an economic foundation for the unification movement, as well as to solve world hunger. In order to sustain and develop the businesses, we must convince the youths to inherit these businesses and projects in Ocean Providence.

c. Create a movement to strategize and implement solutions to world hunger.

Due to the Fall, humankind lost dominion over the creation and thus was put in a position to labor for food. Only True Parents and their ideologies can solve the world hunger problem at the end of the providence. The blessed families must become a global movement to "live for the sake of others" by strategizing and actually solving the world hunger problem following the footsteps of True Parents. We must guide our youths to study and become experts and leaders in the related fields.

3. Brainstorm to come up with strategies to overcome the challenges and achieve the goals. Here are some of the discussion questions that we may use for brainstorming:

a. How can we convince the youths to inherit the ocean-related businesses?

There has been a measurable success at the NOCP to get the youth interested in Ocean Providence, but we need many more youths that can inherit the ocean-related businesses. There are ideas about recruiting GPA graduates directly to businesses. How can we continue to reinforce the vision of Ocean Providence within the movement?

b. How can we work together with CARP, ACLC, and other organizations to synergize?

In the past, Ocean Church in Liberty Harbor Marina used to have a successful ministers witnessing platform called “Ministers & Laymen Fishing Club” where local congregations were invited to attend fishing trips and inter-church tournaments. Troubled youth in the community were also given a chance to learn to be mechanics or fishing captains. How can we share resources for the outreach programs?

c. How can we create sustainable, self-sufficient Ocean Tribe activities?

For now, Ocean Tribe operates with donations from marine businesses, and the members are all volunteers, only available on the weekends. In the past, Ocean Church in Liberty Harbor Marina operated a restaurant, tackle shop, marine supply shop, boat repair shop, and fish sales. There is also an option of creating a GPA-style fundraising team for Ocean Tribe. How can we create a sustainable and replicable model for Ocean Tribe?

d. How can we expand sustainable Ocean Tribe activities in new locations?

True Father intended that the Ocean Church to initially start with 30 locations but later wanted to expand to 300 and even 500 locations in the United States, and later in the world. Although it was not very successful, True Father still continued to train blessed families in the ocean until His ascension in 2012. How can we continue True Father’s wish to globalize Ocean Providence?

Other focused discussions

- In order to create more chances for the youth to experience the ocean challenge, can we start a small-scale ocean challenge in Gloucester?
