Bongchun Adamedes:



One major part of my experience on REAL was the pursuit of Clarity and how attaining it can liberate me from experiencing regret. A lack of Clarity was always something I struggled with and still to this day I do. During my time on REAL it came to my attention that if I want to find more clarity in my life, I need to answer the more confronting, deeper and difficult questions. Questions such as: How do I want to live my life? Who is God for me? Am I living faithfully blind? Where is my place in this movement? What type of son, brother, father do I want to become? Etc. Through this confronting process, with the help of REAL and the people I could be around. I could discover more concrete and developed personal convictions. As well as obtain more clarity, control and integrity within certain topics and personal struggles.

Another realisation for me was the importance of Culture/Environment. Learn how I can contribute to it? And how helpful it is when a healthy one is established. I believe on REAL we were able to create a culture/environment/atmosphere of family, friendship, honesty, trust and non-judgement. Without everyone mutually agreeing to this culture, I don't think I would have felt accepted or free to honestly express myself.

Junior Anae:



I needed to go to real. I knew the staff and heard what they shared in the 2018 summer WS. So I believed in the potential it had for me and my life of faith. I had a hunch it would be similarly structured to done and always wondered what it was like. So I thought of it as a taster.

One of my main reasons was to work on my life of faith. I felt that this was the first time I made a decision that I thoroughly thought through and consciously made myself.

Real for me was an eye opener. To this day it has helped me to make effort into seeing the bigger picture and what it will look like depending on my day to day decisions. Its uplifting to be with people who have gone this path and have found their

direction. The most I got was from testimonies and discussions. I found a lot of answers by just listening to what people shared about going through a problem and what they focus on to overcome it.

One the most important things I learnt was reflecting on the REAL things. Things like the church, my involvement in the church, how DP applies to my life, my responsibility, identity as God's son and what it means.

I needed to go to real and I believe in its potential.

For me REAL provided me a stage to discover my true self through the talks, discussions, and fundraising. Learning from good honest people day by day through the talks and discussions to gain knowledge and talk about what the content meant to me, how I felt about it, and how I could apply it to myself really showed me new paths which I could be talking for a better life. I did think I would be able to achieve those in the coming days declaring it with confidence to myself but when it was fundraising time the reality of my situation and the truths about myself came to bear fruit. To actualize thoughts into action and what I had as a belief of how to live a better life could not be made without real human effort and effort was something I was struggling to make. Despite this outcome I

learnt what was wrong with what I was doing and learnt that I needed to change and learn how to properly aim and act towards the goals I set out for myself.
