In addition to the engaged couples and matching candidates planning to participate in True Parents' Cosmic Blessing Ceremony October 10, 2010 in Korea, we would like America to be well represented in the main international ceremony with the officiators. Each district has been encouraged to identify clergy, Ambassadors for Peace or other previously married couples who would like to receive the Blessing directly from True Parents, to represent their community in this historic ceremony. The following information pertains to these couples, and is also for the family members and guests of all participants who plan to travel to Korea to support them.

- **Schedule for Previously Married Couples, Family and Guests in Korea**
- Married couples and guests should arrive in Korea on October 8th or 9th. Transportation will be provided from Incheon International Airport to the accommodations.
- Participants can plan to depart from Korea on October 11th.
- **Accommodations**

- Family members and guests will be staying either at Cheongshim International Youth Center, or close by at Cheong Pyeong International Training Center.

- **Reporting**

Please include all previously married couples planning to participate in Korea in your weekly district reports, due each Wednesday by 6:00 PM EST. Family and guests traveling to Korea must be included in the itinerary report form from each district (the form that shows arrival and departure information for all participants). Otherwise, no ground transportation or accommodations can be guaranteed.

- **Expenses**

In addition to airfare, previously married couples, family and guests should prepare \$300 for three nights accommodation and meals while in Korea. Previously married couples who are members of the Unification Church, and seek the Blessing as a Blessed Central Family should also offer the Blessing donation fee of \$2,000 per couple. Other couples such as clergy or Ambassadors for Peace should make a personal donation as an offering to receive the Holy Blessing of our True Parents.

- **Ground Transportation**

Once all participating couples and guests have reported their schedules and itineraries, ground transportation will be organized and details will be forwarded to all participants and districts.
