PLEASE DISTRIBUTE TO ALL BLESSING PARTICIPANTS

The following information is for participants and families traveling to Korea for the matching on October 6-8th, and the Blessing on October 10th. Additional instructions will follow soon for those participating in the USA by internet.

I. Schedule

- Candidates for True Parents' matching should arrive at the Cheongshim International Youth Center (Cheonga Camp) on the morning of October 6th. Therefore, arriving at Incheon International Airport on the evening of Oct. 5th or the early morning of Oct. 6th is best. A detailed schedule for October 6-8 for matching candidates is attached. Candidates may depart beginning October 11th.
- Engaged 1st and 2nd Generation couples and previously married couples should arrive on October 8th or 9th, and can depart beginning October 11th.

- The Blessing Ceremony will take place on October 10th at 11:00 AM at the main campus of Sun Moon University in Asan, Korea. Transportation will be provided for all registered participants and guests to and from the ceremony.
- For any registered USA participants and guests who wish, a sightseeing tour may be organized on October 11th. Details will be decided and announced in Korea.

II. Ground Transportation upon Arrival

Korea has already received the flight information for all registered candidates, couples, and family that are traveling to Korea. Only registered participants and family are guaranteed transportation from the airport to Cheonga Camp, and back to the airport after the Blessing. Please read and follow the instructions on attached international memo WMD 2010-33, noting the following corrections/additions:

- Transportation will be provided for all candidates for True Parents' matching arriving on October 5th and 6th, and for all 1st and 2nd Generation matched couples, previously married couples and family members arriving on October 7th, 8th and 9th.
- International staff will be waiting to meet all arriving participants inside of Exit Door 14, at the far western end of the terminal arrival level. The attached international memo WMD 2010-33 provides a map and clear instructions for your arrival.
- If you are arriving prior to the designated transportation days, and need assistance to reach Cheonga Camp, please call Ms. Jiyeon Kim. From the USA dial: 011-82-10-9040-8376. From Korea dial: 010-9040-8376.

III. Accommodations – UPDATED INFORMATION

All USA participants, staff AND families will be staying at Cheongshim Village, a better quality facility near Cheonga Camp. It is the apartment-style building on the left side of the road just one quarter-mile before the entrance to Cheongpyeong International Training Center. Note: accommodations for all Blessing participants who have paid their Blessing fees are covered through noon on October 12th. Family and guests are asked to pay \$300 to cover the cost of accommodations,

transportation and meals for 3 days and nights. Any participants planning to remain beyond October 12th, or guests staying more than 3 nights must arrange and be responsible for the cost of their accommodation.

V. What to Prepare


- Blessing Attire; Brides: wedding dress; Grooms: Dark suit, white shirt, red tie
- Nice Clothing for the Original Palace: the Matching, as well as holidays and other events will take place in the "Cheon Jeong Goong," or original palace. Men should prepare white shirts and ties, women white or light-colored dresses or pantsuits, as is True Parents' tradition, for these events.
- Clothing appropriate for late summer, early autumn in Korea (54-72 degrees Fahrenheit)
- You do NOT need a sleeping bag.
- Be sure to bring an FM radio for simultaneous translation.

Blessing Rings – official rings, 14K gold with a diamond embedded will be available for purchase at the accommodations for approximately \$275 for men, \$240 for women.
