All in all, the workshop schedule successfully struck a balance between spiritual and fun activities, with many lectures (e.g. dealing with the idea of building a bridge between HARP and CARP, the compatibility of studies and faith, etc.), discussions, a prayer evening and also a trip to a climbing forest. 25 bc’s above 18 years of age enjoyed participating in this workshop, and were guided and supported by 8 competent elder bc’s as staff.
