"Our seaside activities this past summer bore fruit," writes Elisabeth Jamen.

"Several persons contacted by our summer team joined us in September, some going immediately to the U. S. for the Day of Hope tour there."

In America, Mr. and Mrs. Reiner Vincenz are leading a team of European missionaries, including 30 from France. New members in September included engineers, professors, industrialists, and students.

Mr. Henri Blanchard and Mr. Jean Penhard, who had attended the first 100 days training program at the Belvedere International Leadership Training Center, led end-of-summer training programs.

Ten to 20 persons usually attend the weekend seminars held every two weeks.

Sometimes new members from Belgium, Luxembourg, and Switzerland also come.

On October 12-14 they invited all the members who had brought a new person during the two previous weeks.

They came with 24 new people to a three-day program of very thorough study.
