

Reading for Saturday, January 16th: Pyong Hwa Gyong, Book 1, God is the Origin of Peace, Korea, 2002

Dr. Hak Ja Han Moon: *"Throughout his life, Jesus never said he wanted to receive love. Rather he said he came to serve, and that he would love even his enemies."*
