Dear Members and Friends,

The Women's Federation for World Peace, International (WFWP) is an NGO working in over 120 nations to empower women and girls through leadership training, education and skills development, and advocacy at major UN Offices. In addition, WFWP maintains one hundred service projects in fifty nations, in the areas of education, vocational training, micro-credit, AIDS prevention education, medical assistance and nutrition guidance.

Since 1997, WFWP, International has been sponsoring programs related to advancing peace in the Middle East. The Women's Conference for Peace in the Middle East (MEW), was established in 1997. This ground breaking series brings women leaders together from throughout the region, on an annual basis, to discuss critical issues as well as develop lasting bonds of friendship.

In May of 2004, WFWP, together with IIFWP, now known as the Universal Peace Federation (UPF), sponsored the historic "Women of Peace" program, which brought 526 women from 41 nations, to Jerusalem.

In May 2014, ten years later, WFWP and UPF are again sponsoring programs related to advancing peace in the Middle East. We would like to inform you of two programs.

You are cordially invited to attend the Third Global Women's Peace Network Assembly (GWPN), to be held in May, in the Middle East. The Assembly consists of two parts.

In the first part, members and guests of WFWP, USA are cordially invited to attend the 18th Women's Conference for Peace in the Middle East, as observers. This conference will be held, at the Landmark Hotel, with the theme, "Women's Partnership in Achieving Peace and Harmony in the Middle East and the World."





Backgrounder

WFWP, International (WFWP), established 1992

WFWP was founded in 1992, by Dr. Hak Ja Han Moon. Dr. Moon and her husband, the Reverend Dr. Sun Myung Moon, who passed away in 2012, dedicated themselves to building a world of peace, as a couple, for more than fifty years. WFWP is an NGO working in over 120 nations to empower women and girls through leadership training, education and skills development, and advocacy at major UN Offices. In addition, WFWP maintains one hundred service projects in fifty nations, in the areas of education, vocational training, microcredit, AIDS prevention education, medical assistance and nutrition guidance.

Women's Conference for Peace in the Middle East (MEW), established 1997

The MEW brings influential women leaders together from areas with a history of conflict, separation, and conquest, from throughout the Middle East region, to have the rare opportunity to sit together at the same table, engage in dialogue and exchange ideas. Heartfelt bonds of friendship have developed. Over the past seventeen years, this series of conferences has been held in Turkey, Cyprus, Greece, and Switzerland.

Middle East Peace Initiative (MEPI), established 2003

MEPI, a project of the Universal Peace Federation, is dedicated to promoting peace and development in the region, with emphasis on interfaith dialogue, people to people diplomacy, service projects, conferences, and interfaith pilgrimages to the holy sites.

Women of Peace, established 2004

The "Women of Peace" program brought 526 women, from 41 nations, to Jerusalem, May 21-28, 2004. Sponsored by WFWP, as well as IIFWP, participants experienced life in Israel through home-to-home visitation; providing care packages for families in Gaza; gifts and visitation to Israeli and Palestinian victims of violence in Hadassah Hospital in Jerusalem; donations and visitation to the Yad be Yad Bilingual School in Jerusalem; as well as through the formation of over 100 pairs of "sisters of peace" who participated in WFWP's "Bridge of Peace" ceremony. More than 200 women signed a Declaration for Peace.

Global Women's Peace Network (GWPN)

The Global Women's Peace Network is a project of WFWP, International, which includes women leaders from all fields. GWPN advocates for personal and leadership capacity development for women; networking and collaborating with likeminded women's organizations and NGOs; in order to influence policy and decision making, on all levels, and build a world of lasting peace.

2. Accommodations and meals at the Dan Jerusalem hotel, including siteseeing; the arrival date is May 12, and the departure date is May 16;

Please note that some countries require the preparation of a visa, to enter Jordan, or Israel, or both, prior to departure. Please check carefully.

Transportation to and from the Middle East is not included in the cost of these packages and is the responsibility of each participant.
