Dear Fellow Chairwomen,

The annual Haiti Summer Service Project is fast approaching. This year our program will run **from June 21-30**. Once more, we will be traveling to **Cap Haitian**, Haiti's second largest city, to continue to provide healthcare education for the women and families plus character education for the youth. Also, this year, we will sponsor a Women's Leadership Seminar for those women in Northern Haiti who are in leadership roles.

We are looking for more volunteers who would like the experience of aiding a third world country. We are seeking nurses, midwives, doctors and anyone with a strong desire to make a difference. Volunteers will need to cover their own airfare as well as pay a \$300 project fee which covers their food and lodging while in Haiti. A flyer, brochure and application can be sent out to anyone who would like to volunteer. **The deadline for applications is May 30th**. We will also accept medicines and medical supply donations until May 30, as well, in order to be able to ship everything to Haiti in time for our project. The need is great and your support is greatly needed.

Finally, we are currently reaching out to find donors who can provide funds to cover the costs of food and water for the anticipated participants. This will cover 3 days of seminars in which one meal-lunch, will be provided and pens and paper for note taking. Please feel free to multiple the flyer and brochure as is necessary to inspire the organizations and individuals you approach. This way they can see the substantial activity of our work in Haiti.

### **GOAL:**

The primary goal of this international service learning experience is to promote world peace while allowing students and volunteers to develop and/ or enhance cultural competence in providing humanitarian aid and medical care while serving and educating needy populations.

This goal will be met by students and volunteers:

1. helping to provide a character education program for the youth.
2. participating in and supporting a healthcare seminar by the Women's Federation for World Peace (WFWP) on "Reflexology, Trauma and Infectious Diseases"
3. participating in a women's leadership seminar sponsored by WFWP.
4. working with volunteer doctors and nurses to consult patients and to help provide medicines donated by Women's Federation for World Peace.
5. visiting mayors and other political leaders to assess the true needs of the Haitian people.
6. touring museums and historical sites to understand the background and the identity of Haiti.

### **INTRODUCTION:**

This project is our seventh annual WFWP service project to Haiti. Last year, students from the University of South Florida as well as volunteers from across America were joined by volunteers in Ouanamithe, Haiti for a 7 day program. Together, we taught character education, healthcare education and family education seminars to 850 participants.

This year we'll be in Cap-Haitian, the second largest city in Haiti. We'll work with the local WFWP chapter and local educators to present the seminars to about 1000 participants. Through our WFWP activities and through meeting with officials, we hope to make a difference in how Haitians live daily. World peace begins on the grassroots level and we hope to effect a sustainable change in the lives of the Haitians we help, thus promoting harmony among peoples and nations.
