

FFWPU Korea: 2025 Heavenly Unified Korea Theory Instructor Education Workshop

A workshop for instructors of Heavenly Unified Korea Theory was held on February 17 at the headquarters of the Family Federation with the participation of about 160 religious leaders, including heads of seven major Christian denominations as well as representatives from Buddhism, Confucianism, and national religions.

On this day, Jin Sung-bae, Director of the Hyojeong International Training Institute, emphasized the importance of solidarity for launching the "Korean Religious People's Holy Community." Additionally, Lee Jong-taek, President of the Presbyterian Church in Korea Reformed General Assembly, and Venerable Bogeom offered congratulatory remarks urging cooperation for unification and peace.

Hwang Bo-kuk, President of Heavenly Korea, explained the historical mission of the Korean people and the advent of True Parents in his special lecture on The Epic History of the Han People of Korea, and emphasized the proper attitude of believers who attend Heavenly Parent.

In the afternoon, Japanese missionaries and Korean instructors lectured on the Heavenly Unified Korea Theory, with participants sharing deep empathy and inspiration.

Finally, Director Jin announced that the "Korean Religious People's Holy Community" would be officially launched at the March 1st Independence Movement Day event, and presented certificates of completion to representative leaders who would implement the Heavenly Unified Korea ideology.
