Family Federation and Segye Ilbo Provide Relief Funds to Support Disaster Recovery Efforts

Approximately 50 members from FFWPU Korea Headquarters participated in flood recovery activities in Bongsu-ri, Sang-myeon, Gapyeong-gun, which suffered major damage from torrential rains on July 29. Church members from across the nation had already been steadily participating in volunteer activities since the 22nd, and this day's activities were carried out at the request of Bang Sang-il, Chairman of the Sang-myeon Family Church Federation.

Bongsu-ri, Sang-myeon, Gapyeong-gun, where the recovery activities took place, is a resort area that many people visit for summer vacation, but was turned into ruins in an instant due to this torrential rain. The public servants carried out recovery work clearing scattered stones, broken logs, and torn plastic, shedding precious sweat even in the sweltering heat.

Meanwhile, the Family Federation for World Peace and Unification and Segye Ilbo delivered 81 million won in relief funds collected for flood victims in Gapyeong-gun, Gyeonggi Province, who suffered major damage from recent record-breaking heavy rains.

Kim Young-seok, Vice President of FFWPU Korea, stated at the relief fund delivery ceremony held at Gapyeong County Office on August 1, "We offer our deepest condolences to Gapyeong residents who suffered damage from this flood," and "We hope that Gapyeong will recover to its original state as soon as possible."

Gapyeong County Governor Seo Tae-won said, "At this time when flood damage was so great, we are very grateful that the Family Federation and Segye Ilbo have taken precious steps for the Gapyeong region."

On this day, Gi-seong Lee, Director of HJ Heaven and Earth CheonBo Training Center and CheonShim Won President, delivered 21 million won in flood relief funds on behalf of True Mother. On July 29, Gapyeong Church had delivered 5 million won in relief funds for damage recovery to the Gyeonggi Province-Gapyeong County Integrated Disaster Site Support Headquarters.

An FFWPU Korea official said, "Being able to participate in this flood recovery activity was effective because churches nationwide had previously established sister relationships with township-level units in Gapyeong County," and "We believe that based on these connections, the mindset of recognizing this as everyone's difficulty and overcoming it together has been at work."
