The Korea 1800 Couples Blessed Families Association held a General Assembly in the Cheon Won Gung Multipurpose Hall on HC 3.23 (9 May) commemorating the 51st anniversary of the 1800 Couples Blessing.

Approximately 1,200 people attended, including some 600 second- and third-generation children, making the gathering especially meaningful as a celebration of harmony across three generations.

The assembly opened with a performance by representatives of the first-generation advisory council.

Jung Jin-ok, president of the Women's Association, and her husband presented a flower basket as an expression of gratitude.

In her opening prayer, Senior Vice President Song Myo-sook recalled the day of the Blessing 51 years earlier and offered thanks for the love of the True Parents.
