63rd Morim Festival Honoring True Mother's First Visit to Busan and a Special Assembly with True Mother

The occasion was marked by a special assembly with the True Parents of Heaven, Earth, and Humankind, held in the grandeur of the Busan Family Church. Lee Gi-shik, the Vice President of the Family Federation for World Peace and Unification Korea, presided over the event. The gathering included distinguished attendees such as Song Yong-cheon, the President of FFWPU International, Song Gwangseok, the President of FFWPU-Korea, and Lee Gi-seong, the Director of Cheonshimwon. The Morim Festival, fundamentally, pays tribute to the special blessing bestowed by the True Mother during her visit to Busan on May 23, 2021. The importance of this day was highlighted during the relocation appreciation event in Gyeongsang Province Busan by Heavenly Korea's sub-region 5 on July 18 of the same year. The festival, along with the Purim Festival which commemorates True Father's arrival at Choryang Station in Busan on January 27, 1951, following his escape from Hungnam Prison during the Korean war, serves as a day of remembrance for the Busan Church.
