FFWPU International's research for global restructuring and reform -- Heavenly Europe

Yong-cheon Song July 2023



As part of the Family Federation for World Peace and Unification's plan for global restructuring and reform, the organization's president, Song Yong-cheon, has begun a worldwide tour across 194 countries. Under the specific directives of True Mother, President Song aims to establish a systematic and efficient management structure to augment the operation and growth of the Family Federation.



First Phase - A New Chapter for Albania

The world tour of President Song Yong-cheon kick-started from the 16th to 17th of June, with the first leg based in Heavenly Europe, Albania. Upon landing at Tirana Airport, President Song's first port of call was a meeting with Continental Director Mike Balcomb and National Leader Mirela Albania to understand the prevailing conditions in the country.

Following this, President Song visited the Albanian Witnessing Center and the Peace Embassy, both of which were funded by generous donations from European families and a gracious grant by True Mother in 2019. In the hallowed confines of the Jeongseong Room (Cheonshimwon) located within the Peace Embassy, President Song offered his respect to the Heavenly Parent and True Parents.

In an emotional prayer, he said, "As True Mother devotes her entire being into establishing the Heavenly Unified World, it is our responsibility to ensure that all of Europe unites in heart and purpose. We must find and educate the next generation, the torchbearers of the future from this space, and guide them

towards a newer, grander Europe."

The Peace Embassy, is a seven-story building located in downtown Tirana, the capital of Albania, and serves as a venue for large and small events, with its good transport links and ample parking space.

Following his visit to the Embassy, President Song graced the Peace Ambassador Invitation Event, themed 'A Positive Model Contributing to Peace.' He highlighted True Mother's ongoing prayers for Albania's prosperity and emphasized the need for significant victories in the peace activities, with Albania's UPF including the Balkan Peninsula at the helm. The event, attended by about 120 leaders and local officials from various sectors.

The subsequent day saw President Song visit the Albania Mullet training center where he conveyed True Mother 's aspirations for nurturing the future talents of Cheon II Guk. In a meeting with President Alfred Moisiu, President Song outlined True Mother's vision. He also introduced Mr. Matsuda, the International President of IAYSP, and stressed on True Mother 's directive for the first generation's teachings to be passed down for the second generation's education.

He then met with the leaders of the second generation and youth association presidents and told them, "Heavenly Europe and Heavenly Albania have the responsibility to cultivate the future leaders of Cheon II Guk and global leaders to build the Heavenly Unified World that True Parents desire." In their endeavor to fortify both their economic base and missionary environment, Albania is taking a leaf out of Romania's book. The latter, under the able leadership of former Association President Jeong Bong-moon, who has successfully established a robust economic foundation, which pivots around the efforts of National Messiah President Shin Gi-young.



Second Phase - A New Chapter for Germany

On June 18th, Song departed for Germany to attend the Heavenly Europe Leaders' Conference. He visited the Camberg training center to partake in the holy day service and the 61st Day of All True Things event. His speech delineated the providential significance of the dedication of Cheonwon Gung Cheon Il Sanctum and the tour's objectives.





President Song, alongside other global leaders such as Sara Amid, Continental Director for the Middle East, and Dieter Schmidt, Central European District Leader, as well as second-generation leaders, FFWPU presidents, and public officials, pledged to do their utmost to circulate True Mother's heartfelt teachings throughout Europe, starting from Germany. Subsequent to this, President Song Yong-cheon, in

collaboration with Dr. Otsuka, the Cheon Eui Won Chair, Continental Director Mike Balcomb, and six district leaders, embarked on a comprehensive review of their existing institutions, public positions, membership, and worship attendance. This audit also extended to the size and scope of the 121 churches across 55 of the 71 countries under Heavenly Europe's missionary purview. Outlining plans for economic independence and an inspiring vision for the future, President Song underscored the potential of the four integral organizations – the FFWPU, UPF, WFWP, and IAYSP of Heavenly Europe. Grounded in the recent teachings of Mother True, these strategies are aimed at fostering short-term policies and operational principles, thereby energizing the organizations into a higher level of activity and outreach.

Finally, under the leadership of Branch Director Moon In-Pyo, they all came together for a passionate prayer session at the Cheon Shim Won Prayer Hall. They expressed their deep longing for True Mother and reaffirmed their commitment to fulfill the mission she entrusted to them.
