

11th Peace Cup World Tong-II Moo-Do Philippines International Tournament

The 11th Peace Cup World Tong-II Moo-Do Philippines International Tournament, organized by the World Tong-II Moo-Do Federation and the Tong-II Moo-Do Philippines Federation, was held from May 3 to 5, 2024, at the Sunhwa International Academy Foundation (SHIAF) in Antipolo, Philippines. This event celebrated the 64th anniversary of the Holy Wedding of True Parents.

The tournament saw the participation of 60 athletes from 21 countries, including Korea, Japan, the USA, the Philippines, Hong Kong, Malaysia, Cambodia, Thailand, Myanmar, Vietnam, Albania, Brazil, DR Congo, Ethiopia, Mongolia, Zambia, Paraguay, Iran, Solomon Islands, Vanuatu, and Samoa. The event was graced by the presence of notable figures such as Dr. Joon Ho Seuk, Founder of Tong-II Moo-Do, Dr. Pyeong Rae Moon, Co-President of the World Peace Martial Arts Federation, Grand Master Takamitsu Hoshiko, Co-President of the World Tong-II Moo-Do Federation, a representative of the Mayor of Antipolo City, and Tong-II Moo-Do practitioners.



The Peace Cup Philippines International Tournament was held to commemorate the 64th anniversary of the Holy Wedding of True Parents, the 45th anniversary of the founding of Tong-II Moo-Do, and the 40th anniversary of Tong-II Moo-Do in the Philippines. Key objectives included laying the foundation for the victorious entrance of True Mother into Cheon Won Gung and Cheon Il Sanctum. Other objectives included, making path for the upcoming 2025 World Cup Tournament in Cambodia, establishing Se Do Won in the World Peace Center in the Philippines and IPLC (International Peace Leadership College), and making Tong-II Moo-Do a core part of the curriculum at Sun Moon University in Korea. The event featured the Tong-II Moo-Do Peace Cup Tournament, Tong-II Moo-Do Workshop, Il Won-Do Training, and the World Tong-II Moo-Do Leaders Meeting.
