

Korea Holds Council of Elders Prayer Meeting for Cheon Il Sanctum Entrance

A significant prayer meeting for the Victorious Entrance into the Cheon Il Sanctum at Cheon Won Gung was held on November 21st on HJ Marina's third floor.
