On Wednesday, July 30th, registration will begin at **9:00AM** at the Adele H. Stamp Student Union in the center of the UMD campus. Orientation will follow with a Kick-Off Luncheon. Each day of the conference will lead participants to discuss and apply the core life and leadership skills to benefit their own lives.



On Saturday, August 2nd, deemed our “**Young Professionals & Alumni Networking Day,**” we will focus on the importance of Mentoring – both of seeking a mentor and how to be a good mentor to others. In the afternoon we will have an interactive session where students can connect with and learn from people living out their dreams, culminating in an elegant evening with performances and a professional networking banquet.
