And I have been searching for a way to restore them.

Around 1996, the National Messiah Providence began. As a National Messiah of Peru, my husband and I spent one year there. Although we could not accomplish the providential mission, we are grateful as we were able to experience and understand the providential hope for South America. Subsequently, due to the economic situation, I became a schoolteacher and continued it for several years.

While participating in morning devotions that started 2 years ago, I have begun my life of repentance and determination. Especially for campus witnessing, I have been trying to go out to the campus almost every day, repenting for my past indifference to the college despite its geographical closeness to my home.

Now, I am leading a life of gratitude every day by experiencing guidance from the spiritual world when meeting students, and grateful for the opportunity to learn from and get energized by young people's sensibilities.
