

The <u>Horn of Africa</u> has suffered and struggled over the years with wars, tribal conflicts, famine, corruption and poverty. However, there are vast untapped natural resources and ingenuity among its talented population. Magdi Amin has founded the <u>African Renaissance Partners</u>, <u>Horn of Africa Fund</u> to practically bring together private investment, local entrepreneurs and government support to improve the lives of people in this part of the world. The plan for African Renaissance Partners, and Mr. Amin's investment experiences illustrate the principles behind Social Value Investing.
