Children's Summit, 18.74 "The family has the primary responsibility for the nurturing and protection of children from infancy to adolescence. Introduction of children to the culture, values, and norms of their society begins in the family. Accordingly, all institutions of society should respect and support the efforts of parents and other caregivers to nurture and care for children in a family environment."
