The 12 holy grounds were in Mount Faver Park, Katong Park, Punggol Park, Yishun Safara, Woodlands Town Garden, Bukit Batok Nature Reserve, Nanyang Technological University, Chinese Garden, the National University of Singapore, the Singapore Botanic Garden, the Macritchie Reservoir and Real Hill City Park.
