Founded in 1992 by Dr. Hak Ja Han, the Women's Federation for World Peace (WFWP) has empowered women as leaders in peacebuilding for over 30 years.

Rooted in the understanding that God embodies both masculine and feminine characteristics, WFWP affirms that men and women have equal value and qualities that complement one another.



FOSTERING RECONCILIATION

One of WFWP's signature initiatives, Bridge of Peace, fosters reconciliation among people from divided backgrounds.

Grounded in the belief that lasting peace begins within, WFWP offers education and ceremonies to help heal social divisions and build a more peaceful world.



THROUGH SERVICE

With the heart of a mother to care for the children of the world, WFWP puts the “logic of love” into action - bringing hope to the most underprivileged through service.

One example is the Schools of Africa project. Beginning in 2001, the project supports 9 schools across 8 African nations - providing educational funding, supplies, and essential resources.
