The athletes were accommodated in the very attractive Vivaldi Park Resort, a ski resort 1 hour north-east from Seoul.

From March 22nd the competition started at the Namyangju Sports Cultural Center in Seoul. On this day the preliminary rounds for football, basketball and volleyball took place. Without too much difficulty, the European teams could win every game, and advance into the final for each of these team events. There was a very good atmosphere

in the European team. Although the athletes came from all corners of Europe, centered on the European flag, we could make one unified spirit. The Americans were cheering a lot their athletes, so we tried to cheer even more. We became stronger and stronger. One Albanian fundraising team came to help—it was great!

In the beginning, we were worried about competition from the Northeast Region, because we know that Russia is very good in volleyball, but it turned out that NER brought teams from a sport institute in Hong Kong. Their teams were well versed in sports, but not strong enough, to compete against our Czech volleyball teams. The Bosnian basketball team, were also at a higher level and made it to the final. In the football semifinal we played against the USA—a team of mostly 2nd Generation, who had a good spirit and fought bravely, but could not defeat our Serbian team.

Jan Tesař, our Czech runner, made Gold in the 400 m.

Then came the time for table tennis and badminton: Iva Mejdlová made Gold in table tennis for the women, and Zdeněk Zaspal made Silver after a very close battle against the men's Hong Kong champion. We were very surprised about our lovely badminton couple from Scotland, they played so well, and both made Gold. Both the table

tennis and badminton were very high level competitions, and exciting to watch. Everybody—our football, volleyball and basketball teams – were there cheering them on. I think they never had so many people cheering them before, and they really enjoyed the support.
