On Saturday morning, June 18, 2011, Mrs. Soo Yung Noh transitioned to the spirit world after a year-long battle with advanced stages of cancers. She was 59 years old.

Mrs. Soo Yung Noh has been Boon Bong Wang (BBW) of Estonia since 1996. She served as a missionary in Argentina from 1993-1996 and attended True Parents directly in their South American providential work. During her years in America, she supported her family and mission country by operating NJ Korean Food Corp. in Bergenfield, NJ, and Yama Sushi in South Orange, NJ.
