CARP Hosts Seminar on Global Citizenship and Universal Responsibility

On 12 May, CARP, alongside the Bar Society, organised a seminar at the University of Greenwich titled "Global Citizenship and Universal Responsibility", featuring Professor Fuyuko Takita as the guest speaker.
