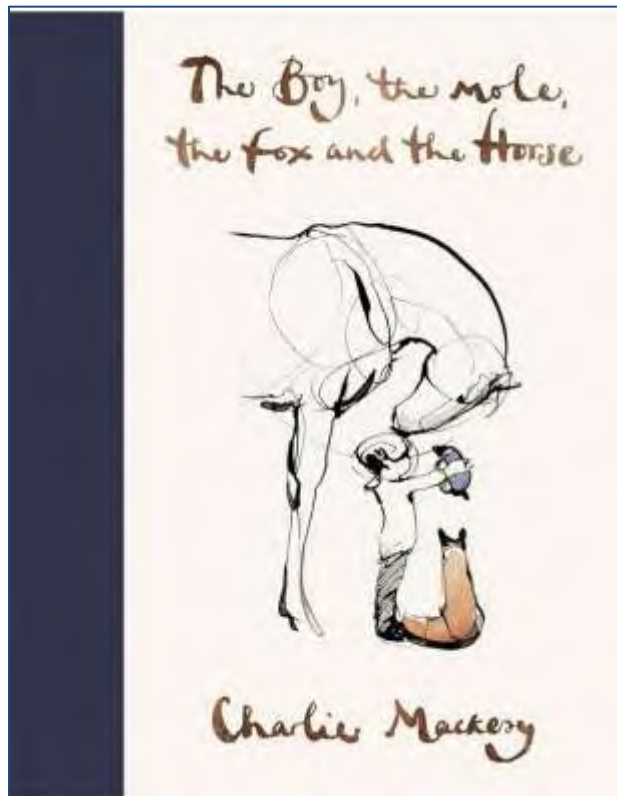


FFWPU UK: Book Review: The Boy, the Mole, the Fox and the Horse

Through simple yet meaningful conversations between four unlikely friends, the book encourages readers to reflect on compassion, self-worth, forgiveness, kindness and caring for others. Its messages are easy for children to understand while also offering deep encouragement for adults.

The calm artwork and handwritten style create a peaceful reading experience, making it an excellent choice for family reading time or bedtime reflection. Many families may find that

the story opens valuable conversations about emotions, relationships, and the importance of supporting one another.
