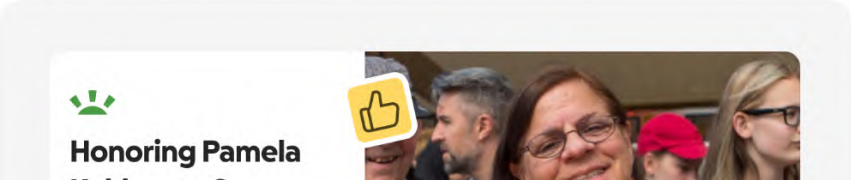

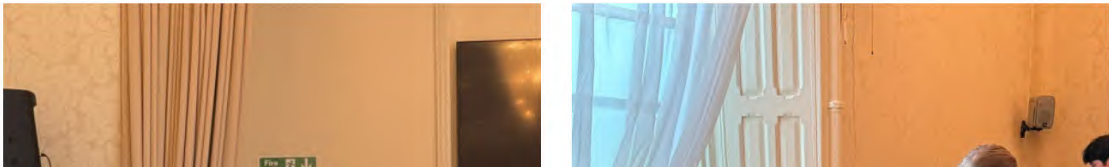
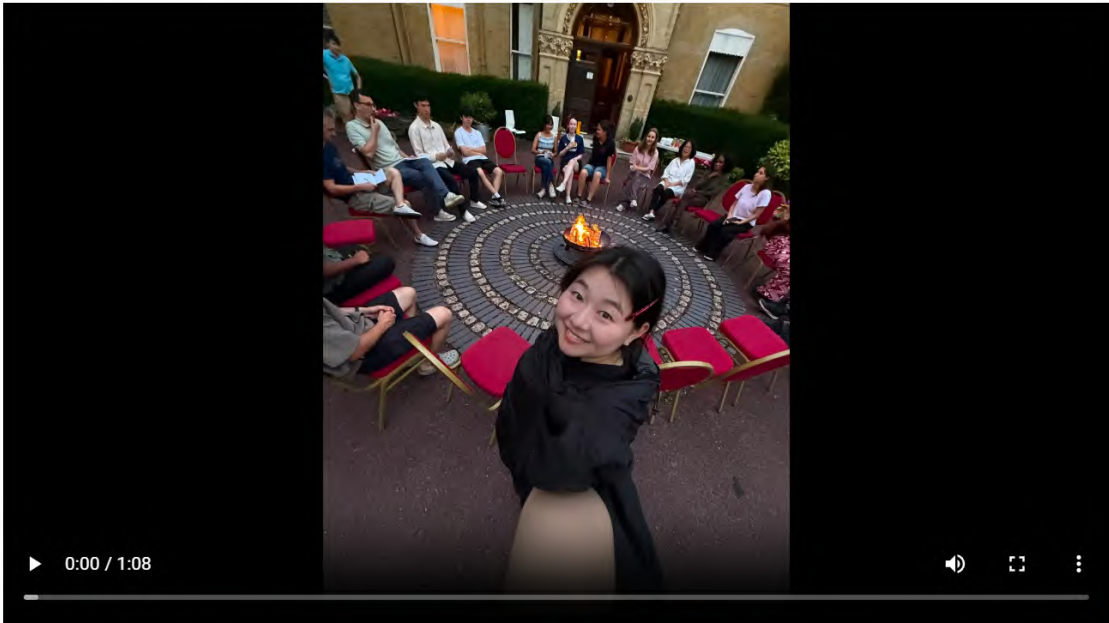

Members' Spotlight | Celebrating The Empower Team

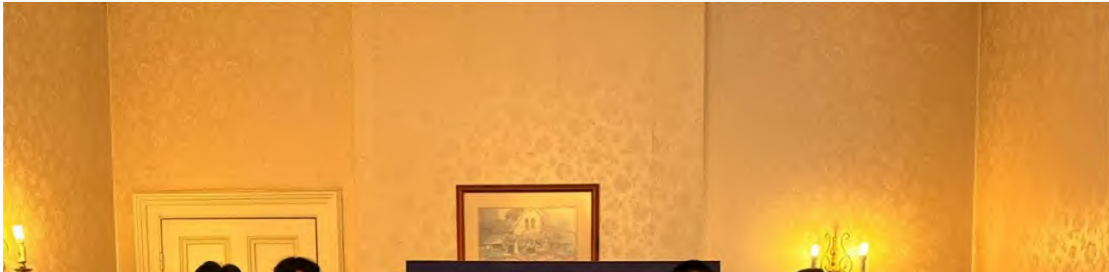

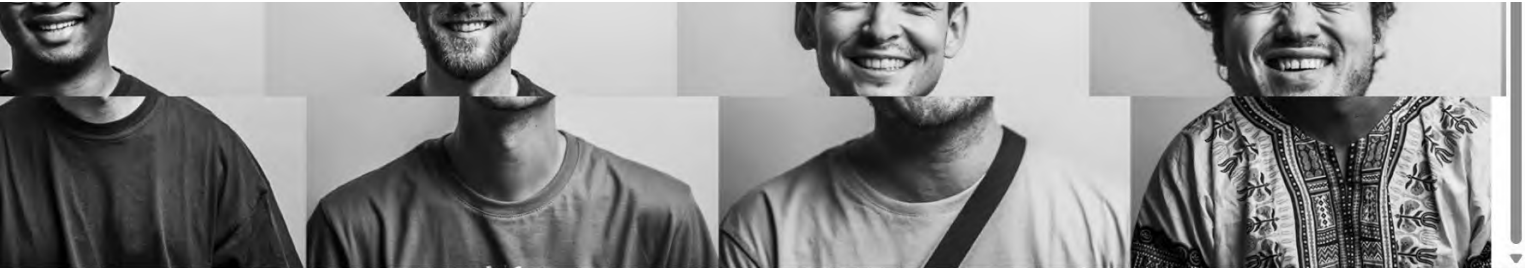

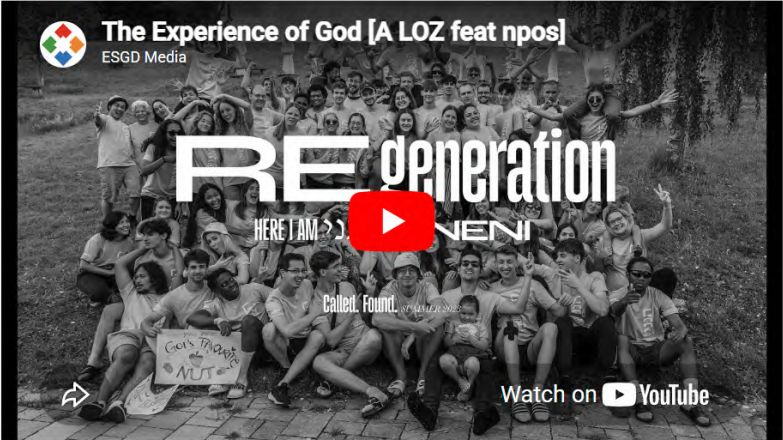
