Action 1: Clarification of FFWPU's vision and mission for UK members and guests.

FFWPU's Reason for Being

1. Attend to True Parents by contributing to their global efforts for peace and reconciliation.
2. Support youth and single adults to discover God's Three Great Blessings as a life goal, prepare for the Holy Marriage Blessing, and build Blessed Families.
3. Share the Holy Marriage Blessing with married couples of all backgrounds and faith traditions.
4. Develop communities of Blessed Families across the United Kingdom.
5. Provide education for individuals in different age groups and life circumstances to grow in God's Three Great Blessings.
6. Support blessed families to transform their neighbourhoods and communities as Tribal Messiahs.
7. Partner with NGOs and faith communities to provide services and support for children and parents in underserved communities.
8. Promote the family as the school of love and advocate for policies that recognise the family as the cornerstone of social and economic development.

Action 2: National Director and River South pastor to develop updated and simplified outreach and education content with the London CARP team. Hereby, we pay special attention to True Mother's recent words and emphasis.

Action 3: Sharing and discussion of "New Members Journey" based on a UX approach developed by the FFWPU EUME working group.

Action 5: Regular review of the Sunday Service liturgy and practice with UK Pastors to make the Sunday Service newcomer and family-friendly.

Action 6: Review Divine Principle Workshop Follow-up

- Review follow-up and transitions between stage 1 and stage 2 (usually 1-day workshop)
- Review follow-up and transitions between stage 2 and stage 3 (usually 3-day and 7-day workshop)

Action 7: Development of a national public life program for missionaries, volunteers and new members. (As a possible option for stage 3 engagement.)

Action 8: Facilitating principled educational content and services in the areas of the three blessings for members and guests. For example:

- Personal Life Vision and Goals (1st blessing)
- Healthy Cooking for Families (1st blessing)
- Digital Health & Wellbeing (1st blessing)
- Spiritual Growth as a Couple (2nd Blessing)
- Being a Growing Parent (2nd Blessing)
- Healthy Family Traditions (2nd Blessing)
- Decluttering and Home Organisation (3rd Blessing)
- Financial Literacy (3rd Blessing)
- Gardening (3rd Blessing)
