On October 25 and 26, the River South Community (RSC) and CARP Greenwich team hosted a 2-day "A New Page" Divine Principle workshop at Livingstone House, joined by the North Thames HTG team.

In total, 22 participants took part, including 5 guests, creating a warm and lively atmosphere throughout the weekend. The theme was 'A New Page', to encourage participants to reflect on their journey so far and embrace a new start, a new chapter in their lives connected to Heavenly Parent. It was a reminder that no matter where we are, there is always an opportunity to begin again, to grow, and to rediscover God's dream within our own lives.



Across the two days, participants explored six key Divine Principle topics: The Universal Principle, The Principle of Creation (our original dream), The Fall and Restoration (the origin of conflict), Waku Waku (the path to our original self), and Models of True Love (the lives and vision of our founders). The content was carefully tailored for new guests, focusing on the essence of the Principle, Heavenly Parent's dream, and the meaning of living with true love and a clear conscience. Having our second-generation members lead the lectures created a more relatable and engaging experience for participants, while also serving as a meaningful leadership opportunity for the lecturers themselves.

Alongside the lectures, there were games, outdoor activities, and plenty of moments for reflection and connection. On the Saturday evening, everyone gathered around a fire to share and discuss, with hot chocolate and snacks, and ended the night with fireworks and sparklers. It was a joyful and moving

experience that brought everyone closer together. The atmosphere throughout the weekend was truly beautiful and impactful, showing how much can be shared and felt even in a short time.
