On November 1st, the Seonghwa Caring Ministry hosted a webinar on 'Preparing for our Eternal Life - Practical Guidance'. Franklin F. was the facilitator. He first acknowledged and thanked Françoise M who from a personal tragic event in her life had raised up and initiated the Seonghwa Caring Ministry. Franklin's main point of his talk was the importance of relationships. After having conducted Seonghwa ceremonies for many years, he came to the conclusion that after all what really count in our life are our relationships of heart, relationships between husband and wife, parents and children, our relatives, our friends. Relationships are not just limited to this physical realm; they accompany us to the spiritual world. We can ask ourselves: who will speak for me at my Seonghwa ceremony? How many will be there to give you a hero's send off? He also mentioned that at a recent Cheon Shim Won it was stated that our 3 main treasures are True Parents, Blessed families and Seonghwa Ceremony.

After his introductory talk Franklin invited the members of the Seonghwa Caring Ministry committee to give their testimonies and lessons learnt after having dealt with the passing of their loved ones. Some very moving testimonies and useful guidance were given by Masakazu H speaking from his hospital bed, Anne K. Masumi Y, Annerose A, Françoise M and Pascal M.

The audience then was given the opportunity to give their comments and advice. Some very valuable contributions were given adding to the topic of the webinar. A question was raised: 'Are we ready for the journey?' Some spoke about the value of the Seonghwa ceremony versus a regular funeral and the need to leave very clear instructions behind to our family regarding our own Seonghwa. Other recommendations were to write our own eulogy, find a way to share passwords and financial information, apply for a Will and Power of Attorney and more.
