

Sydney, Australia bans distributing literature to hamper Unification Church

In Sydney, center leader Carl Redmond reports that their members are circulating a Principled "National Anthem" which Carl received from the spiritual world to churches, schools, and to the prime minister and cabinet ministers.

Their witnessing has been somewhat hampered by a ban from the city council on distributing literature on the streets. Currently they are reaching people by teaching the Principle in their homes and street preaching in Hyde Park. Carl reports that the United Nations Association has been responding to them, and that they will participate in one of their projects.
