With a small house and a large shop/steel building, we have a place to start and there's plenty of room to run around and to grow. There are about 200 fruit and nut trees and ample irrigation water is provided by the county for a nominal fee.

Along with continuing our Full-Year training and summer camps, we plan to develop a true organic farm and practice the same model of care we have in raising our young people to raising our plants and animals. As a training organization, this hands-on experience will be implemented in our curriculum.
