

Youth and Students for Peace (YSP) Cote D'Ivoire Launched at National Library

Under the sponsorship of the President of the UPF Cote D'ivoire, Mr. AKA Sayé Lazare, YSP Cote D'ivoire made its official launch on Saturday June 16, 2018, at the National Library of Abidjan-Plateau.

This ceremony brought together 200 people including 150 young people, students, NGO leaders and 50 personalities.

The theme for the event was “The Role of Youth and Students in Building a Sustainable Peace Culture”.

The ceremony began with the national anthem of Côte d’Ivoire, followed by the opening prayer by Pastor Amichia Joseph. The welcoming address was given by Miss ASSOUAN CHINI, Secretary General of YSP Côte d’Ivoire. A video presentation of YSP’s international and national level activities was next.

Rev. BEUGRE Richard, National Leader of the FFWPU Côte d’Ivoire gave the main message of the launch of YSP. A strong and instructive message that encouraged youth to engage in God-centered responsible behavior, including sexual purity from adolescence to marriage.

The highlight of the ceremony was the presentation of the certificates of appointment of Mr. Brou Konan Jean Marie and Miss ASSOUAN CHINI Véronique, respectively as President and Secretary General of YSP Côte d’Ivoire.

Mr. Brou Konan Jean Marie emphasized in his message about our role as parents, educators and leaders vis-à-vis young people. He explained that this role goes far beyond giving them an intellectual baggage. What matters, he stressed, is their moral and ethical education, because their values are formed by educating their heart and their personality.

Cultivating the heart and the personality has a great impact on our ability to achieve certain intangible goals, sources of lasting fulfillment and happiness. He ended his remarks by explaining that to realize his hopes and dreams, a young person needs a loving family environment where true love can shape his conscience and his heart.
