

UPF UK: David Hanna's Presentations to UK Ambassadors for Peace

London, United Kingdom -- Ambassadors for Peace and other UPF supporters were invited to a seminar that explained the founders' vision for peace.

The half-day seminar was held on July 8, 2023, in the UPF-UK offices in the Lancaster Gate area of London.



Rev. Dr. David Hanna, the UPF chairman for Northern Europe, delivered three enlightening presentations that explored the profound universal values underpinning the Universal Peace Federation:

- "Universal Values as a Foundation for Peace";
- "Love Lies at the Root of Conflict"; and
- "Healing and Reconciliation: Toward the Ideal."

"Heart is the impulse to experience joy through giving and receiving love," Dr. Hanna said. He addressed fundamental aspects of human existence, surprising the audience with his thought-provoking insights on a Saturday morning.

By delving into these core principles, Dr. Hanna shed light on the intrinsic connection between love, conflict, and the path to healing and reconciliation.
