connection to Jesus and joined the Unification church a year later. Bill was Blessed in marriage at Madison Square Garden as part of 2075 couples on July 1, 1982 with his beloved wife, Mineko. Together they raised three children in New York City to fulfill his hometown mission. He was instrumental during their school years, advocating for their education and was proud to see them all achieve successful careers, much beyond his humble beginnings.



As a true New Yorker, Bill was never shy in expressing himself and will be remembered for his strong will, boisterous spirit, and caring heart. He loved betting on horses (bringing the kids to Saratoga and Belmont in the summers), watching hockey with his son, taking road trips with his wife, eating fresh seafood with his daughters and talking to anyone who would listen.

He realized his passion seven years ago, spreading True Parents' teachings through his Hoon Dok Hae online ministry. His passion and commitment to his faith also led him to participate in missions around the world,
