Kathmandu, Nepal -- UPF and the International Association of Parliamentarians for Peace (IAPP) in Nepal organized a conference on the "Peaceful Reunification of the Korean Peninsula and World Peace: Challenges and Opportunities" on January 25, 2021 at the Kathmandu Marriott Hotel with 106 participants, including six parliamentarians, in attendance.

Former ambassador of Nepal to the United States, Mr. Shankar Pd. Sharma, talked about the economic benefits of reunification and said that when the two Koreas unify, Korea will be one of the largest economic powers in the world. He praised UPF for its efforts to support reunification of the peninsula.

Deputy Secretary General of the Asian Regional Institute of Juche Idea, Mr. Subash Kaji Shrestha, added that the reunification of the peninsula would provide a road map for peace to all nations and advance peace in the world.
