The Holy Marriage Blessing Ceremony, commonly known as “The Blessing,” is a tradition with over six decades of history. Beginning in 1960 with the marriage of Dr. Hak Ja Han and Rev. Sun Myung Moon, it was established to uplift and transform the standard of love in marriage.

The Blessing’s focus is to elevate marriages and create families that focus on bringing joy to God and the world.



TO CREATE ONE FAMILY

The vision is simple: to connect all people as one family under God by cultivating loving and harmonious families rooted in faith.

This begins as couples dedicate their marriage to God. As families grow, that love naturally expands—shaping their children, strengthening communities, and contributing to a more peaceful world.

One of the most beautiful aspects of The Blessing is its ability to unite couples beyond boundaries of race, religion, culture, and nationality.

By bridging traditional lines of division, it lays a foundation for healing and peace. In Dr. Hak Ja Han's vision, "Grandparents from enemy nations or religions will unite through the beautiful grandchildren they share in common."

The Blessing is famous for dozens of large-scale events where thousands of couples gather from around the world to dedicate or re-dedicate their marriages to God.

Smaller scale Blessings Ceremonies are also conducted in local communities and by individuals, bringing the marriage Blessing to millions worldwide.
