70 religious leaders from around the world just flew to South Korea.

Not for a conference.

To visit an 83-year-old woman in a detention cell.

Dr. Hak Ja Han has been held at Seoul Detention Center for 157 days.

On February 26, a delegation led by Bishop Luonne Rouse visited her behind bars.

They came as part of the 2026 World Clergy Leadership Conference National Prayer Rally.

What they found: a religious leader who, rather than asking for sympathy, spent her limited visitation time encouraging her visitors to carry out God's will.

The delegation issued a joint petition calling for:

- Humanitarian treatment for an elderly detainee in declining health
- Protection of religious freedom and conscience
- Reconciliation over retribution

Johannes Ndanga, president of the Africa Christian Council International, said the scene reminded him of the persecution of the innocent in the time of Jesus.

Bishop Rouse stressed this was not about defending one organization. It was about defending universal principles of justice and conscience.

The petition will be formally submitted to South Korean judicial authorities and shared with international human rights bodies.

At 83, Dr. Hak Ja Han tells her visitors from behind bars. "Do not worry about me. Let us pray for Heaven and for the world."

Four Resolutions to Attend Heavenly Parent in Substantial Reality

Beloved and respected blessed families of the Unification community throughout the world,

I sincerely pray that the abundant blessing and love of Heavenly Parent and True Parents will fill the lives of each of your family members this coming week.

1. Summary of Last Week's Message

Last week, the sermon from the worship service to commemorate the Holy Births of the True Parents of Heaven, Earth, and Humankind and the 13th Anniversary of Cheon Il Guk Foundation Day became my message for the week.

This week, I would like to summarize that message and reflect with you on what kind of transformation we must achieve in our lives in this era of attending Heavenly Parent in substantial reality, and with what determination and practice we should move forward.

2. Four Resolutions to Serve Heavenly Parent with Our Lives

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

During the worship service for True Parents' Birthday last week, we shared four resolutions as we welcomed 2026 as the first year in the era of attending Heavenly Parent in substantial reality. In this week's message, I would like us to engrave them once again in our hearts and examine how we are living them out in our daily lives.

First: The practice of faith — are we truly making "attendance" part of our everyday life?

We have now passed beyond the era of seeking the invisible God and entered the era when we should live with our Heavenly Parent substantially in our daily lives. That means we must ask ourselves whether our daily lives are worthy of participating in that attendance.

Is the inspiration we feel in worship carried into our choices and attitudes throughout the week? Do our words and actions reflect the dignity of Heaven? Faith must not remain based on an event or atmosphere—it must become the order and standard of our lives. Only then does the quality of our faith rise.

Second: Taking responsibility — Are we demonstrating filial love (hyojeong) through our lives?

Last week, we resolved to go beyond "displays of filial piety" and practice "responsible filial love and devotion." What matters now is not the decision but the action.

We must ask ourselves whether, in our families and mission fields, we are truly establishing models of true love and true families, and whether we are preparing fruits to offer in our reports before Heaven. Numbers and form are not the essence; the honest report we must offer should be of transformed lives and established communities.

Third: The universalization of identity—are we breathing together with the world?

We are the sons and daughters of Heavenly Parent. That identity must not remain confined to particular boundaries, but must be fully connected to society.

We must reflect on whether our community is trusted within society, and whether we are sharing in our neighbors' pain. More important than explanations or justifications is the evidence based on life itself. Our mission is to leave behind a record of truth that the world will willingly acknowledge.

And lastly, Fourth: The substantialization of Love — Is love manifested beyond religion?

Until now, we have cherished true love and heart within ourselves. Yet now it must appear as a reality—something our spouses, children, and neighbors can tangibly experience.

If our faith still remains at the level of concepts and words, the signboard of religion cannot be taken down. But if we ourselves become the substance of love, the world will see Cheon Il Guk without us needing to explain it.

1. 지난주 주간 메시지 요약

지난주는 '천지인참부모님 성탄 및 천일국 기원절 13주년 기념예배' 말씀으로 주간 메시지를 대신하였습니다.

이번 주에는 그 예배 말씀을 다시 한 번 요약하며, 하늘부모님을 실제로 모시는 이 시대에 우리가 어떠한 삶의 변화를 이루어야 하는지,

그리고 어떤 결의와 실천으로 나아가야 할지를 함께 점검하고자 합니다.

2. 하늘부모님을 실제로 모시는 4가지 결의

사랑하는 식구 여러분,

지난주 성탄 기념예배 말씀을 통해 우리는 2026년, 하늘부모님을 실제로 모신 시대의 원년을 맞이하며 네 가지 결의를 나누었습니다.

이번 주간 메시지에서는 그 내용을 다시 한 번 마음에 새기며, 우리의 삶 속에서 점검해 보고자 합니다.

첫째, 신앙의 생활화 즉 '모심'이 일상이 되고 있는가입니다.

우리는 이제 보이지 않는 하나님을 향해 나아가던 시대를 지나, 실제로 하늘부모님을 모시고 사는 시대에 들어섰습니다.

그렇다면 우리의 하루는 과연 그 모심에 합당한 삶이 되고 있는지 돌아보아야 합니다.

예배 시간의 감동이 일상의 선택과 태도로 이어지고 있는지, 우리의 말과 행동이 하늘의 체면이 되고 있는지 점검해야 합니다.

신앙이 행사나 분위기에 머무는 것이 아니라, 생활의 질서와 기준이 될 때 비로소 신앙의 격은 높아지는 것입니다.

둘째, 책임의 실천화 즉 효정을 삶으로 증명하고 있는가입니다.

지난주 우리는 '보여주기식 효도'를 넘어 '책임지는 효정'을 실천하고자 결의했습니다.

이제 우리에게 중요한 것은 결심이 아니라 실천입니다.

각 가정과 선교 현장에서 참사랑과 참가정의 모델을 실제로 세워가고 있는지, 하늘 앞에 결과로 보고할 열매를 준비하고 있는지 스스로에게 물어야 합니다.

숫자와 형식이 아니라, 변화된 삶과 세워진 공동체가 우리의 진정한 보고가 되어야 합니다.

셋째, 정체성의 보편화 즉 우리는 세상과 함께 호흡하고 있는가입니다.

우리는 하늘부모님의 자녀입니다. 그 정체성은 특정 울타리 안에 머무는 것이 아니라, 사회를 향해 열려 있어야 합니다.

우리 공동체가 사회 속에서 신뢰받고 있는지, 이웃의 아픔과 함께하고 있는지 돌아보아야 합니다. 변명이나 설명보다 더 중요한 것은 삶의 증거입니다. 세상이 스스로 인정할 수밖에 없는 진실의 기록을 남기는 것이 우리의 사명입니다.

마지막 넷째, 사랑의 실제화, 즉 종교를 넘어 사랑으로 드러나고 있는가입니다.

우리는 지금까지 마음속에 참사랑과 심정을 간직해 왔습니다. 그러나 이제는 그것이 배우자와 자녀, 이웃이 체감할 수 있는 실제로 나타나야 합니다.

만일 우리의 신앙이 여전히 관념과 언어에 머물러 있다면, 종교의 간판은 내려질 수 없습니다. 그러나 우리가 사랑의 실체가 된다면, 굳이 설명하지 않아도 세상은 천일국을 보게 될 것입니다.

3. 실천:

사랑하는 식구 여러분,

Participants train in discipline, loyalty, and filial piety through Tongil Budo—a martial art rooted in Unification movement teachings—to strengthen their resolve for her health and release from detention.

Hoshiko emphasized inheriting the devoted spirit of figures like Dr. Hee Chol Son, who has maintained prayer vigils near the detention center, and invoked True Father's calligraphies on bravery, loyalty, and utmost sincerity to move heaven.

The workshop occurs amid ongoing legal proceedings against Dr. Hak Ja Han, arrested in September 2025 on bribery charges related to alleged gifts to the previous first lady, followed by indictment, detention periods, and health-related temporary releases.

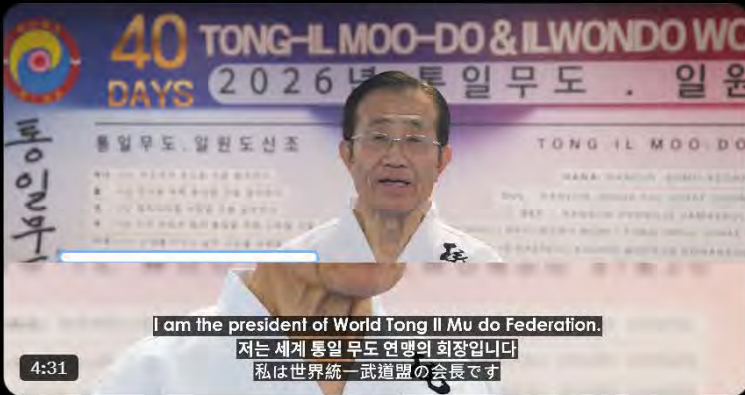
The Family Federation views her situation as unjust persecution of a global peace advocate, while authorities pursue accountability for influence-peddling allegations.

Such events reflect the movement's commitment to spiritual solidarity during its leader's hardship.

This gathering is significant because it shows how faith communities mobilize cultural and physical practices to support imprisoned or persecuted leaders, blending martial discipline with prayer for liberation.

In a polarized South Korea where religious groups face scrutiny, these efforts highlight resilience and devotion.

When a global faith movement channels training and prayer toward freeing its elderly founder, what does it reveal about the intersection of spirituality, loyalty, and justice in modern society?
