As we prepare for the HELP! Appeal for Religious Freedom at the Japanese Embassy in Washington, DC on March 19, I want to share a brief update with you.

Our brothers and sisters in Japan are facing profound injustice. The dissolution of the Family Federation there has created real fear and uncertainty for many faithful families. At this moment, they are looking to the global family with hope that their voices will not be forgotten.

Here in America, we are preparing to stand with them.

On March 19, we will gather peacefully in Washington to make a sincere appeal for dignity, justice, and religious freedom. Our goal is to bring at least 500 members and friends together while

Prime Minister Takaichi is visiting the United States. It will be a clear and heartfelt expression that people of faith will not remain silent when religious freedom is threatened.

To support this effort and strengthen our broader religious freedom initiatives, we launched a special campaign several months ago. Thanks to the generosity of many members and friends, \$589,000 has already been raised toward our goal of \$650,000.

I am deeply grateful for the faith and generosity that has brought us this far.

We want to raise \$61,000 more to support our efforts this week in Washington DC.

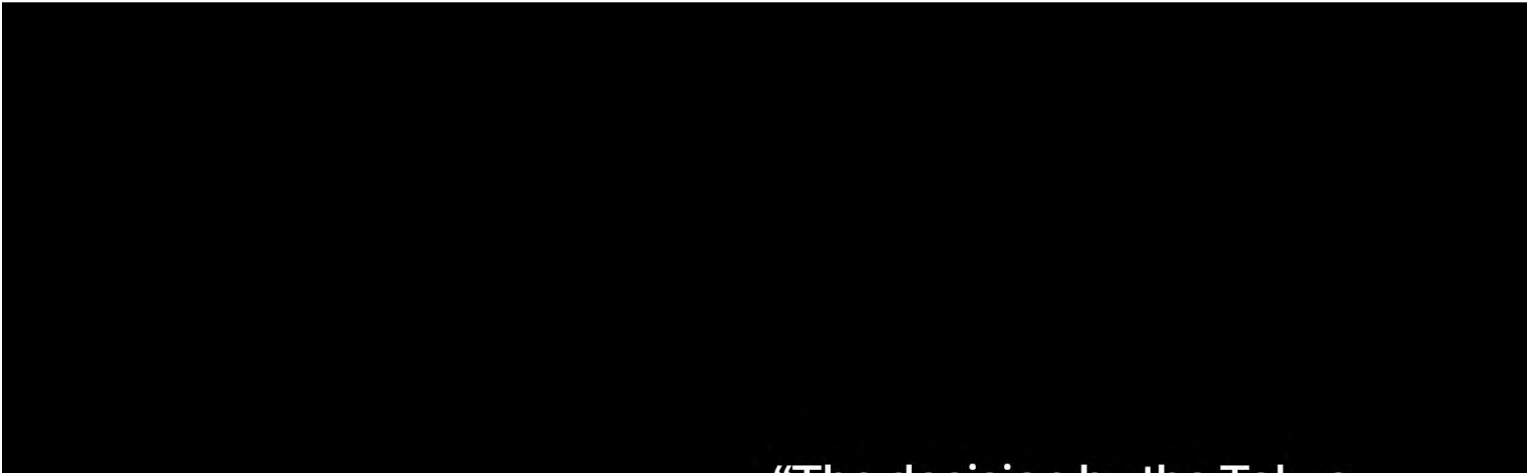
