Forty-three attend Tribal Messiah sampler workshop at Clifton NJ Family Church

Forty-three people attended a "We Can Do It" sampler workshop at Clifton Family Church in New Jersey on Sunday, May 29. Demian Dunkley, director of Evangelism at Family Federation for World Peace and Unification (FFWPU) USA, led the program as a way to get the tribal messiahship ball rolling, and also as an introduction to the full, two-day "We Can Do It" workshop that will take place on the weekend of July 16 - 17.

Participants were guided through self-reflection and discussion, designed to introduce them to the concept of trinity-centric tribal messiahship. They also were led through some goal setting, in order to create actionable, measurable goals, including a five-minute goal that they then were asked to complete.
