21-DAY OUTREACH OPPORTUNITY

Starting on Wednesday, 11-24-2010

Dear Friends,

Deep down, do you love the idea of sharing the “Breaking News” of True Parents' advent with your neighbors and friends but find yourself thwarted by “life” getting in the way?

Well, if so, please consider joining in an “end-of-the-year/starting-the-new-year” effort reaching out to new and old friends and neighbors, introducing them to Father’s book, his disciples, and our community.

Starting on August 1, 2010 our national movement, with Rev. in Jin Moon’s guidance, launched a “Six Month Development Initiative.” This period will end January 31, 2011, and was designed to lay a foundation for a resurgence of church growth in 2011. To join this effort, the outreach team is launching three 21-day outreach periods.

The first of the three 21-days sets begins on Wednesday, Nov. 24, and runs until Tuesday, December 14; the second 21-day set starts on Saturday, Dec. 18, and runs until Friday, Jan. 7, 2011; the third 21-day set starts on Tuesday, Jan. 11, and runs until Jan. 31, 2011. There are two periods of three days – after set one and set two – for reflection, evaluation and adjustment. During each of these three periods the outreach team and our pastor encourages everyone to (consider one, more, or all):

- 1. Distribute Father’s autobiography (set your goal).**
- 2. Set a spiritual condition of your choice (prayer, fasting or bowing).**
- 3. Read or re-read Father's autobiography (343/21 = 16 1/3 pp. per day).**
- 4. Attend a Lasting Imprint lecture with Miilhan Stephens (after Sunday service).**
- 5. Participate at an autobiography book table at a public location.**
- 6. Help prepare a public program at New Hope Family Church.**
- 7. Help hold a full one-day DP workshop (at the CARP center).**

Participate as much or as little as you like. Three periods of 21 days allow a more focused effort, faster adjustments, and more choices of participation. Participate in one, two, or all three 21-day periods.

To better facilitate communication, we are considering a Web site or Facebook page through which everyone can share stories, inspiration, and ideas.

So, please join us in this first of three outreach periods, starting this coming WEDNESDAY, Nov. 24.

To discuss week 1 progress, please join the outreach team over lunch (provided) next Sunday, Nov. 28, in the Multipurpose Room, after Sunday service, from 12:30 – 2:00 p.m.
