

Restoration of Fuerte Olimpo, Paraguay (Pantanal)

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Earlier this year, missionary Ever Antonio Gavilán León and his family were appointed to manage the Fuerte Olimpo Church, which had been abandoned and uninhabited for many years.

This site is an important historical site in the Pantanal Providence and for the entire unification movement.

It is the closest village to Nabileque, where True Parents declared "the Original Holy Ground, Root Holy Ground, and Victory Holy Ground" on July 27, 1999.



It was also the site where the Japanese national Messiahs were gathered for a 40-day workshop starting on August 1 of the same year to start the Leda project.

The restoration of this site will be an essential step in the restoration of the Holy Ground of Nabileque.

Ever and his family manage Fuerte Olimpo Church together with local resident Guido. They started a small farm to build an economic base. Because this location is far from urban areas and distribution is limited, fresh vegetables are hard to come by and can be sold at a relatively high price.

Fortunately, Ever has been involved in farms since childhood, and they have successfully created a beautiful mini-farm.

Currently, they are planting tomatoes, peppers, lettuce, cucumbers, watermelon, parsley, carrots, and melons.
