SUMMER DP WORKSHOP

Mission: Give the youth an opportunity to connect with and understand the Divine Principle in its basic form and experience God's creation

Vision: Our youth experience God's word and creation through practicing the word, giving the word, and experiencing it through creation.

Introduction:

No doubt it has been a tumultuous time for our movement within the past 5 to 10 years. Especially at this time, while Mother is detained (at the time of this writing), it is easy to feel lost and unstable in our faith. It is for this reason that we feel called to return to the essence of our movement. Each of us has had different experiences as we have grown spiritually.

The common ingredient amongst them is the universal principle, which holds true no matter who, what, when, where or why. While we have been seeking to understand the Principle in the context of Mother's recent words, at times we have focused so deeply on connecting with the spirit, that we have lost hold of the truth.

The explanation that we have long used to teach these principles, The Exposition of the Divine Principle, has been a cornerstone of how we teach the universal principles for decades. There is no question that there is immense depth, power, and knowledge within this book. As such, we want to lay a foundation of faith within this young generation that is based on these words from our True Parents. We seek to survey the Divine Principle, emphasizing the Principle of Creation, the Fall, and the Principle of Restoration and True Parents, alongside accessory topics.

A deeper way to learn is to teach. Teaching brings to light the gaps in our understanding, piques our curiosity and embeds the ideas deeper into our memory. Our aim is that our youth can learn to teach Divine Principle to their friends and family in a succinct way. The term 'napkin lecture', is an apt analogy; a simple explanation within a casual conversation you have with a friend accompanied by diagrams that you can draw on a napkin.

In addition to learning the Divine Principle, it would behoove us to experience it. There is no one like True Father to explain why: "We can learn everything from nature. I discovered more than 80 percent of the principle in nature. I loved to spend nights in nature. One moonlit night I was walking through some pine trees. There were pine tree branches crisscrossing like intertwining arms. A half moon was shining through the branches. Words cannot express such mysterious beauty. You have no idea how magical it was to hear the wind blowing while I was meditating in the midst of those drooping pine trees. I will never forget it. You must feel the joy. Do you understand?" - Oct 3, 2001.

Backpacking gives us a great opportunity to experience the principle on several fronts. Immersing ourselves in nature gives us the opportunity to see the Principle in action. The way the water flows, the way the plants and fungi support or compete with one another or the way animals chirp to one another are all examples of the Principle in action. It is

healing to immerse ourselves in the cradle of creation.

Similarly, we can see the principle working within and between us. Backpacking is not an easy feat. To carry 20-30 pounds of gear and food on your back for 10-15 miles requires resilience, determination, and a supportive spirit toward one another. Also, it can be that very nature, whose beauty we seek to experience, that is the reason we struggle. Flies, mosquitos, dirt, hot sun, or the combination of them all, can get on our nerves. It is through dealing with our own emotional response to these things that we can learn to practice the Principle.

It is always a blessing to meet with other children of True Parents under one roof, whether it is that of the Wolfenbergers, or the starry night sky. We hope that through this experience we all can take one step closer to our Heavenly Parent and True Parents and deepen our embrace for one another.

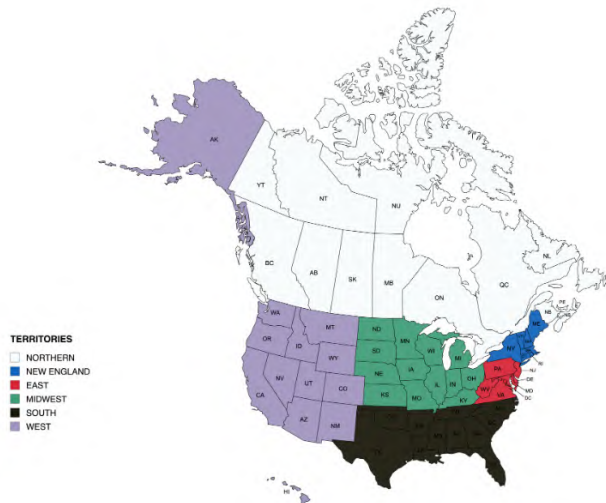

Code of Conduct Acceptance

BCSF VISION AND CODE OF CONDUCT

Our mission at the Blessed Culture and Sports Festival is to provide the platform where we can display our best form in sportsmanship and artistic expression and to share that with friends and family. This event is a time and place where we bring together the best of what our communities have to offer from around the country. Although we come from many different territory and backgrounds with differences in culture, our commonality is the shared values and beliefs that we have been given by our community of faith that binds us together. To honor that shared experience, it is very important to us that we are able to uphold a certain standard of behavior and attitude and do it where it is evoked from the best parts of ourselves. We speak of being a family and so we ask that everyone looks out for each other physically and spiritually.

As a family friendly event, we ask that all the participants and attendees refrain from certain behaviors that reduce the quality and experience of everyone involved. Our code that we ask you to agree to abide by while you are at the BCSF is as follows:

REGISTRATION and PARTICIPATION

All persons on site must be registered for the event according to their participation level. **Not being properly registered will result in being asked to leave the grounds.** Registration is defined as:

- Payment for any sports, cultural, spectator and/or accommodation arrangements
- All sections of registrations forms MUST be filled out
- This Code of Conduct must be signed and dated
- Registration bands must be worn around the wrist throughout the duration of the event

Participation or observation of cultural events is reserved for participants aged 16 and above. Participation in sports events is reserved for participants aged 16 and above, exceptions are up to the team captain's discretion

ILLEGAL SUBSTANCES

No possession, use or distribution of drugs, alcohol or tobacco products or substances considered illegal by the US Federal Government will be allowed.

With substantiated claims, the BCSF staff reserves the right to search the possessions of any individual suspected of any of these actions.

With substantiated claims, the BCSF staff reserves the right to outsource search methods, including but not limited to bringing a detection dog on campus.

Any behavior associated with being under the influence of any of these listed above, will result in BCSF Core Staff taking any of the following actions at their discretion:

- Expulsion from the event
- Forfeiture of any admission fees and immediate disqualification from any event
- Parent(s) and/or immediate supervisor(s) will be informed and individual(s) will be asked not to return for a period of (2) years

INAPPROPRIATE BEHAVIOR

The following behavior is deemed inappropriate and may result in being asked to leave AND/OR forfeiture of any admission fees AND/OR disqualification of any event for the following reasons:

- Excessive noise after evening closing and before the first morning event
- Any behavior which causes excessive physical or mental discomfort to fellow participants

- Any verbal abuse or disrespectful language
- Inappropriate attire
- Tampering with BCSF equipment and/or disrupting any event, presentation or show

CURFEW AND ACCOMMODATIONS

All Participants must follow curfews and accommodation rules

Anyone not registered for accommodation must leave grounds by 12: 00 AM

All grounds will be OFF LIMITS from 11:00 PM to 6:00 AM the following day

- This excludes sleeping areas and the designated “Hang out” areas
- “Hang out” areas will be closed at 2:00 AM. **At this time, all participants MUST return to their registered accommodation area (tent or dormitory)**
- There will be NO sleeping in any area except those designated as Official Accommodations by BCSF staff

Dormitories will be divided by gender. No one of the opposite gender will be permitted in at any time.

Any individual without dormitory wristband will NOT be allowed in the dormitory area except for showers

MINORS and ON-SITE GUARDIANS

Anyone under the age of 18 may not attend unless there is an adult guardian above 18 who is LEGALLY responsible for their well-being and behavior.
