Seoul, South Korea - The World Summit 2022 for Peace on the Korean Peninsula was held in Seoul, Korea, from February 10 to 14. Some 160 nations were represented, including 157 nations with diplomatic ties to one or both of the Koreas. The Summit was sponsored by the Universal Peace Federation (UPF), an NGO in General Consultative Status with the Economic and Social Council of the United Nations. Hosted by UPF Co-Founder Dr. Hak Ja Han Moon, the Summit was Co-Chaired by H.E. Samdech Hun Sen, Prime Minister of Cambodia, and H.E. Ban Ki-moon, Secretary-General (2007-2016) of the United Nations; Dr. Yun Young-ho, Director General of the Universal Peace Federation, and Dr. Thomas G. Walsh, Chairman of the Universal Peace Federation, and H.E. Khuon Sudary, Vice-President of the National Assembly of the Kingdom of Cambodia served as Co-Chairs of the Executive Organizing Committee.

In response to South Korea's strict sanitary and travel restrictions caused by a sharp increase in COVID-19 infections, the Summit combined in-person attendance and virtual participation. Eighty-five world leaders addressed more than 300 people attending in person, as well as a global virtual audience participating through the world's largest 360-degree interactive broadcast. Eleven key political and civic leaders from around South Korea, including provincial governors and major city mayors, offered their congratulations.

Cambodian Prime Minister Samdech Hun Sen opened the Summit at the Lotte Hotel World in Seoul. Then, virtual greetings were given live from the Korean National Assembly by Deputy Speaker Lim

Jong-seong and former U.S. Speaker Newt Gingrich, and from the Japanese Diet by Hon. Yoshiaki Harada, former Minister of the Environment.

An official government statement at the Opening Plenary was sent by video from H.E. Macky Sall, the African Union Chairperson and Senegalese President. In person, other former heads of state and government also gave their keynote addresses as follows: U.S. Vice President Mike Pence, Canadian Prime Minister Rt. Hon. Stephen Harper, Israeli Prime Minister Ehud Olmert and Sri Lankan President Maithripala Sirisena, along with European Commission President Romano Prodi and Brazilian President Michel Temer by video.



The Summit sessions featured heads of state, government ministers, parliamentarians, scholars, and media representatives from each region of the world. They addressed the many challenges to peace on the Korean Peninsula, such as resistance to denuclearization, strained Korea-Japan relations, tensions between China and the United States, and core differences between North and South. At the same time, they offered a range of solutions, such as encouraging new friendships with the North Korean people through trade, tourism, sports, music, and cultural exchanges.

On February 12 in the morning, the Sunhak Peace Prize Award Ceremony honored Professor Dame Sarah Catherine Gilbert of the University of Oxford for her role in developing the AstraZeneca vaccine and ensuring its availability at affordable price, and Gavi, the Vaccine Alliance, for its achievement in dealing with the COVID pandemic throughout the world as well as its ongoing work to provide vaccines to more than 800 million of the world's neediest children. H.E. Dr. José Manuel Barroso, former EU Commission President and Chairman of the Sunhak Peace Prize Selection Committee, presented the award to Professor Gilbert, and Dr. Thomas Walsh, Chairman of the Sunhak Peace Prize Foundation, presented the award to Gavi.

The Founder's Special Award was given by Dr. Hak Ja Han Moon to Samdech Hun Sen, Prime Minister of the Royal Government of Cambodia, recognizing his role in lifting his country from civil war and a murderous past into prosperity and peace.

Founded by Dr. Hak Ja Han Moon in 2013, the Sunhak Peace Prize selects laureates for their service to global peace in the areas of sustainable human development, conflict resolution or ecological conservation. Previous awardees include climate change advocate H.E. Anote Tong, president of Kiribati (2003-2016), and Indian aquaculture pioneer Dr. Vijay Gupta; Italian humanitarian surgeon Dr. Gino Strada and Afghan refugee educator Dr. Sakena Yacoobi; African Development Bank Group President Hon. Dr. Akinwumi Adesina and women's rights activist Ms. Waris Dirie; Palestinian Bishop Munib Younan and Senegalese President Macky Sall.

The Global Summit concluded with a "One Million Rally of Hope" and renewed calls for unity on the Korean Peninsula. The main event was held at the HJ Global Arts Center near Seoul, and broadcast simultaneously in 52 locations in South Korea as well as throughout the world.

In his closing remarks H.E. Ban Ki-moon, Secretary-General (2007-2016) of the United Nations and Co-Chair of the World Summit 2022, expressed his hope that "one day in the near future the people of the South can directly engage with their brothers and sisters in the North." He was followed by speeches from former U.S. President Donald Trump, former Japanese Prime Minister Shinzo Abe, former European

Commission President Dr. José Manuel Barroso and Nigerian President Muhammadu Buhari.

Each continent was represented by prominent speakers who shared with the global audience their assessment of the prospects for peace on the Korean Peninsula. Former U.S. Vice President Mike Pence, former U.S. Secretary of State Mike Pompeo and U.S. investor Jim Rogers spoke in person.

During World Summit 2022, official government statements from European heads of state were conveyed through video by President Ilir Meta of Albania and Prime Minister Albin Kurti of Kosovo. Other prominent speakers spoke by video. These included former heads of government: European Commission President Romano Prodi, H.E. Dominique de Villepin of France, H.E. José Maria Aznar of Spain, and H.E. Ahmet Davutoğlu of Turkey.

The prestigious speakers from Africa included: H.E. Macky Sall, Chairman of the African Union and President of Senegal; H.E. Muhammadu Buhari, President, Nigeria; H.E. Dr. Hak Ja Han Moon closed the Summit with a moving speech thanking world leaders for their contributions in support of peace on the Korean Peninsula. She expressed her concern for the multiple challenges to peace in the world, notably in Eastern Europe and Northeast Asia, and for the damage caused to the environment by the lack of human responsibility. "These challenges cannot be met by human effort alone," she said. "Building one family under God is the only way to bring about a world filled with freedom, equality and peace." In an emotional conclusion, she asked the citizens of North and South Korea and all nations present to join with her to achieve unification on the Korean Peninsula and true peace throughout the world.

Pompeo blasts China as world leaders gather at Seoul peace summit

China bears the blame for the immeasurable suffering from the COVID-19 pandemic over the past two years and the entire world must speak with a loud, unified voice in condemning Beijing's human rights abuses and disdain for faith and freedom, former Secretary of State Mike Pompeo said at an international rally over the weekend.

Speaking to world leaders and international dignitaries at the World Summit 2022, Mr. Pompeo offered a harsh critique of China's leadership and the lengths to which it went to hide the COVID-19 outbreak, which subsequently spread around the globe, killing millions.

The former top U.S. diplomat sought to draw a link between Beijing's handling of the health crisis and its fundamental opposition to the concepts of peace and freedom that eventually may lead to the reunification of North and South Korea.

"This virus was foisted upon the world by a Communist Party that refused to do the divinely right thing in the moment. It put its own citizens on planes knowing that they were contagious. ... What conception of humanity finds this remotely decent or acceptable?" Mr. Pompeo asked.

"What vision of a higher power justifies such wanton diminution of the value of each human life? This is, ladies and gentlemen, not about the Chinese people. It's about this entity and its leaders, the challenges it presents to those of us who seek peace and harmony in our world," he said.

"This Communist Party can't tolerate why we're here today," Mr. Pompeo said.

Mr. Pompeo delivered his powerful speech at an event created to promote world peace and mobilize hope behind efforts to end the North Korean nuclear crisis and the decades-old conflict between North and South Korea.

World Summit 2022 was organized by the Universal Peace Federation (UPF) and brought participants from every continent together, both virtually and at an in-person program in Seoul. Mr. Pompeo, former Vice President Mike Pence, former Defense Secretary Mark Esper and a host of other high-profile former officials were among the featured speakers.

'Seeds of peace'

Former President Donald Trump delivered a recorded video message. He said his diplomacy with North Korea, including his three in-person meetings with the country's leader, Kim Jong-un, helped lay the groundwork for eventual reunification.

"We have planted the seeds of peace and cooperation, and now we must let them bloom and grow just like a giant tree," Mr. Trump said. "To waste that chance would be a profound tragedy."

Mr. Trump blasted the Biden administration for its handling of North Korea. He said Pyongyang's spate of major missile tests underscores its lack of respect for current leaders in Washington.

In his remarks in Seoul, Mr. Pence did not mention the Biden administration by name.

Still, he suggested that Washington is not responding aggressively enough to North Korea's missile tests and said the Trump administration's diplomatic breakthrough with North Korea proved that "peace follows strength."

"Weakness arouses evil, and a resurgence of missile tests and provocations from Pyongyang, [including] this week's promises to shake 'the world,' are a testament to this truth," said Mr. Pence. He was referring to North Korea's claim in recent days to be confronting the U.S. by "shaking the world" with missile tests.

The Trump administration's historic diplomacy, however, ultimately failed to achieve a breakthrough denuclearization deal.

Mr. Trump walked away from a second summit with Mr. Kim in 2019. He said the North Korean side demanded sweeping sanctions relief in exchange for only a limited commitment to destroy part of the nuclear arsenal it had been building for decades in violation of repeated U.N. Security Council resolutions.

Attempts at diplomacy with the North Koreans have gone nowhere during the years since, and the Kim regime engages in increasingly brazen missile tests.

'That day will come'

Hope for the reunification of the Korean Peninsula was a dominant theme at the World Summit. In his keynote address, Mr. Pompeo said China could play a constructive role in that effort but its leaders have chosen a different path.

"North Korea takes its cues from the [Chinese Communist Party]. We talk about Chinese conflict with Tibet, with Mongolia, with the people of Hong Kong and their efforts in Taiwan," Mr. Pompeo said. "We should not forget the long border and the conflict between the Chinese Communist Party and the Korean people of the North."

international figures. The World Summit was hosted by Dr. Hak Ja Han Moon, a cofounder of UPF, and co-hosted by Cambodian Prime Minister Hun Sen and former U.N. Secretary-General Ban Ki-moon.

Mrs. Moon, the widow of the Rev. Sun Myung Moon, is the leader of the Unification movement, which grew from the Unification Church that Rev. Moon founded in 1954 - a year after a U.S.-backed armistice froze a war between North and South Korea.

She and her husband devoted their lives to the reunification of the Korean Peninsula and to the promotion of world peace. They founded The Washington Times in 1982.

A range of prominent political figures and current world leaders participated in the weekend summit, including Nigerian President Muhammadu Buhari, Albanian President Ilir Meta, Senegalese President Macky Sall and former European Commission President Iose Manuel Barroso.

Mr. Pence and other speakers praised the work of Mrs. Moon on Friday.

Former House Speaker Newt Gingrich, who also addressed the gathering in Seoul, praised participants for coming together in the name of peace for the world and for the Korean Peninsula.

"The human race will move forward to safety, to prosperity and to freedom only if good people take the time, show the courage and get involved," Mr. Gingrich said.

"The human race is at one of those amazing turning points when the technology that brings us together can also be the technology that destroys us, and I think these efforts, this commitment to talk together, to bring together the kind of really remarkable groups that come from all over the world to this kind of conference, to make friendships, to go back home realizing that you have things in common that allow you to build a better future, I think all this is very, very vital," he said.

Mr. Pence and Mr. Pompeo expressed optimism for the Korean Peninsula.

"Based on the progress that I saw under the Trump-Pence administration, I remain supremely confident that a brighter future is on the horizon for the United States, for the people of the Korean Peninsula, the Asia-Pacific and the world," Mr. Pence said.

"No oppressive regime can last forever," he said. "For inside every human heart is an unquenchable fire that burns to be free. Inside every human soul is an insatiable desire for freedom."

A unified Korea, Mr. Pompeo said, is within reach.

"The moment for reunification will happen," he said. "That day will come."

GLOBAL LEADERS CALL FOR PEACE ON THE KOREAN PENINSULA

'WE CANNOT CHOOSE WAR TO END WAR'

South Korea-The World Summit 2022 (Summit for Peace on the Korean Peninsula) ended its first day in Seoul, Korea, with dozens of world leaders calling for an end to the Cold War's last remaining division — the Korean Peninsula.

The Koreas need to "swiftly conclude a peace treaty" and end the war, said Samdech Hun Sen, Prime Minister of the Royal Government of Cambodia. "My country has been divided by war," but it ended 20 years ago, thanks to the "best choice" of dialogue, he said. "We cannot choose war to end war," he added.

"Peace on the Korean Peninsula has symbolic meaning to all of us," said H.E. Ahmet Davutoglu, Turkey Prime Minister (2014-2018). The Cold War divided Germ Yemen, Vietnam and Korea, but all but Korea have since reunited, he said. "It is time for a new era on the Korean Peninsula."

Some 160 nations are represented in the Feb.10-14 World Summit 2022, including 157 nations with diplomatic ties to one or both of the Koreas. The Summit is sponsored by the Universal Peace Federation (UPF) and the Royal Government of Cambodia, hosted by UPF Co-Founder Dr. Hak Ja Han Moon, and co-chaired by H.E. Hun Sen and H.E. Ban Ki-moon, former Secretary-General of the United National

Speakers addressed several hundred people attending in person and a global virtual audience; organizers said 3,500 broadcast networks around the globe were covering

US Vice President Mike Pence (2017-2021) was one of many speakers who saw great hope for Korea's united future. "There's nothing that's impossible when nations work together for the common good," he said, referring to the global response to the COVID-19 pandemic. This international cooperation is why "the dream of a united Korea is possible," he said.

"We are all for peace. The question is what are we prepared to do to make it possible," said H.E. Ehud Olmert, Israel Prime Minister (2006-2009), who praised the Trump/Pence administration's peace efforts in the Middle East. "Words are one thing and real progress is another," said Kyra Phillips, ABC Correspondent and veteran newswoman who recalled seeing promises of Korean peace evaporate instead.

Many world leaders offered wisdom from their own or their nation's histories of peacebuilding. "Peace is cultivated in courage, trust and dialogue," said Senegal President Macky Sall, who is chairman of the African Union.

There is "defense power" and "diplomacy power," but "peace power" - the ability to build peace through honest, personal relationships — should not be underestimated, said Hon. Yoshinori Ohno, Minister of the Environment in Japan (2018-2019).

"I personally think the North Koreans are seriously thinking of the possibility of opening up," said Dr. Claude Begle, former Swiss Member of Parliament. What is needed is a safe platform for dialogue to eliminate fears, establish mutual trust and plant "seeds for peace," he said, noting that the UPF is well-positioned to offer such a

"We can fix this together... but we need the whole world on board," said US broadcaster Trish Regan.

Many speakers presented challenges to peace, such as resistance to denuclearization; foreign troops in South Korea; strained Korea-Japan relations; tensions between China and the US; and core Korean differences, such as the North's devotion to a single leader and its own nationalism versus the South's determination to form a highly prosperous, modern democracy that values individual freedom

Summit speakers also offered a range of solutions, such as encouraging new friendships with the North Korean people through trade, tourism, sports, music, and cultural exchanges. Hon. **Lim JongSeong**, one of 35 Members of the South Korean National Assembly participating in the Summit, spoke of forming an official agency to assist with reunification of Korean families. US businessman **Jim Rogers**, chairman of Beeland Enterprises, energized the audience with his presentation on opening up the 38th Parallel to permit construction of an international highway-and-tunnel system, "so people can drive from Tokyo to London."

Michael Breen, a Seoul-based journalist and author, dropped a solution at the feet of UPF, suggesting that the NGO hold its next World Summit in Pyongyang.

US House Speaker Newt Gingrich (1995-1999) summed up many of the speakers'

sentiments when he said, the numan race will move forward to safety, to prosperity and to freedom only if good people take the time to show courage and get involved."

"Only by honoring God can we end this sad division in North and South Korea," said Pastor Paula White-Cain, spiritual adviser to President Donald J. Trump.

Stephen Harper, Canada Prime Minister (2006-2015); Hon. Yoshiaki Harada, Japan Minister of the Environment (2018-2019); H.E. Chuichi Date, Japan President of the House of Councillors (2016-2019); H.E. Romano Prodi, Italy Prime Minister and President of the European Union Commission (1999-2004); H.E. Michel Temer, Brazil President (2016-2018); Mr. Thomas P. McDevitt, Chairman of The Washington Times; Hon. Kim Hyon Hwan, South Korea Vice Minister of Culture, Sports & Tourism; Mr. Charlie Hurt, Opinion Editor of The Washington Times; Rt. Hon. Ganesh Prasad Timilsina, Chairman of the National Assembly in Nepal; Mr. Jacques Marion, Regional Co-Chair of UPF-Europe-Middle East; H.E. SUNHAK PEACE PRIZE LAUREATES HONORED FOR WORK IN COVID-19 RESPONSE

South Korea—The World Summit 2022 (Summit for Peace on the Korean Peninsula) honored a British vaccinologist and a global vaccine alliance with the 5th Sunhak Peace Prize as part of its second day's activities in South Korea.

The Feb. 10-14 World Summit 2022 has gathered world leaders and a global virtual audience to hear and discuss ways to peacefully conclude the Cold War's last remaining division—the Korean Peninsula. Some 160 nations are represented at the Summit, including 157 nations with diplomatic ties to one or both of the Koreas.

The Summit is sponsored by the Universal Peace Federation (UPF) and the Royal Government of Cambodia, hosted by UPF Co-Founder Dr. Hak Ja Han Moon, and cochaired by Cambodia Prime Minister Samdech Hun Sen and H.E. Ban Ki-moon, former Secretary-General of the United Nations

Friday's Sunhak Peace Prize Award Ceremony honored Dame Prof. Sarah Catherine Gilbert of Oxford University and Gavi, the Vaccine Alliance as the 2022 Laureates.

Prof. Gilbert explained how she had spent years in vaccinology fighting known diseases but also preparing for a future "Disease X." On Jan. 1, 2020, when she read an article about a terrible new respiratory sickness in China, she rushed to organize a response. The Oxford-AstraZeneca vaccine for COVID-19 was ready for its trials within a few weeks—and today, 2.5 billion doses have been produced for use in 170 countries. Low-income countries pay little to nothing for the vaccines, she said, per an agreement that this vaccine must be available to all people.

Now that there are additional vaccines to fight COVID-19, she said, "we can now look forward to our lives going back to normal.

Dr. Seth Berkley, CEO of Gavi, the Vaccine Alliance, explained how his organization coordinated the COVAX Facility to ensure that developing countries could get vaccines as easily as wealthy ones. The goal was "an equal chance for a healthy future," said Dr. Berkley, adding that COVAX has delivered 1 billion COVID-19 vaccine doses to 144

The biennial Sunhak Peace Prize was founded by Dr. Moon in 2013 to honor the legacy of her late husband, Rev. Dr. Sun Myung Moon. Laureates are chosen for their extraordinary service to global peace in one of three areas; sustainable human development, conflict resolution or ecological conservation. They receive a medal, plaque and a cash prize.

In 2020, the Founder's Special Award was added to the Sunhak Peace Prize. This year, the second special award was given to Samdech Hun Sen, Prime Minister of the Royal Government of Cambodia, for his decades of efforts to heal Cambodia from its civil war and murderous past, and lift it into prosperity and peace.

"Some may take peace for granted, but those who have lived through war know how precious peace is," said Mr. Hun Sen.

Many of the day's speakers talked about the importance of religious freedom and prayer as essential for resolving the division on the Korean Peninsula

"We know that peace can only be fully achieved through faith," said Pastor Paula White-Cain, head of the Paula White Ministries and spiritual adviser to former President Donald J. Trump.

"Religious freedom is a building block of peace and security," said Amb. Callista Gingrich, U.S. Ambassador to the Holy See (2017-2021), who noted that 80% of the world's population still lives in nations, including China, Russia and North Korea, where religious freedom is "highly or severely restricted."

Rt. Hon. Stephen Harper, Canada Prime Minister (2006-2015) said he viewed religious freedom as so vital to peace and national stability, he established an Office of Religious Freedom during his time in office.

Others stressed the unity of humanity to effect change. "One person's prayer may be a dream, but the prayers of millions become a vision," said Prophet Samuel Radebe, founder and leader of The Revelation Spiritual Home in South Africa. Without the Creator, he added, "the problems of this world cannot be solved."

South Korean leaders Hon. Hyung Suk Kim. former Vice Minister of the Ministry of

Unification, and Hon. Shim Jae Kwon, chairperson of the Foreign Affairs and Unification Committee (2012-2016), were among those recounting the frustrating history of peace talks in Korea.

Negotiations in Pyongyang with North Koreans were "difficult" and "disappointing," said Hon. Mike Pompeo, US Secretary of State (2018-2021). We believed there was a "tangible opportunity to create peace," he said, but "sadly, we didn't get all the way."

Hon. Mark Esper, US Secretary of Defense (2019-2020), offered several proactive steps to take, such as deepening relations among the US, South Korea and Japan, and "engaging China together." These kinds of bonds can be expanded to many other countries, such as Europe, India and island countries in Asia, he said.

Others pointed to reunification examples in Germany and Vietnam, which took different paths to resolve their divided nations. "Vietnam now has a bubbling economy" and Germany's economic successes are well known, said H.E. Maithripala Sirisena, Sri Lanka President (2015-2019).

"We need new imagination," said H.E. Suos Yara, chairman of Cambodia's Commission of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation. Diplomatic topics could include getting a Korean peace treaty signed as soon as possible; converting the DMZ to a place of peace and free-trade zone; and investing more in cultural cooperation, given the warm inter-Korean experiences in the 2018 Winter Olympics in PyeongChang.

"Leaders need to sit down with their adversaries and say, 'What can we do to work this out?" said Hon. Dan Burton, who served three decades in the U.S. House of

GLOBAL SUMMIT ENDS WITH ONE MILLION RALLY OF HOPE AND RENEWED CALLS FOR UNITY ON THE KOREAN PENINSULA

South Korea—The World Summit 2022 (Summit for Peace on the Korean Peninsula) ended its third day with global encouragement, practical advice and prayers for renewed efforts to unite the Korean Peninsula and end the last division of

"Despite your difficult circumstances due to the coronavirus pandemic, I trust that you, our global leaders, will achieve peace and unification on the Korean peninsula with your commitment and devotion. Thank you," said Dr. Hak Ja Han Moon, cofounder of the Universal Peace Federation (UPF) and host of the World Summit

The Feb. 10-14 Summit was sponsored by UPF and the Royal Government of Cambodia. Cambodia Prime Minister Samdech Hun Sen and H.E. Ban Ki-moon, former Secretary-General of the United Nations, served as Summit co-chairs.

The Summit drew participants from some 160 nations, including 157 nations with diplomatic ties to one or both of the Koreas. Nigeria, for instance, has "enjoyed cordial relations with both Koreas in trade, commerce, education, cultural exchange and technology transfer," said Nigerian President Muhammadu Buhari. "And so, when it comes to what needs to be done to ensure a lasting peace on the peninsula, we are happy to be part of it," he said.

In her address, Dr. Moon explained that building one family under God is the way to bring about a world filled with freedom, equality and peace

As tears filled her eyes, she asked "the citizens of North and South Korea" to join with her and "unite as brothers and sisters." "Only then can we achieve true unification on the Korean Peninsula," she said, adding that when the people of the world become sons and daughters of God, we can "achieve world peace and unification in our lifetime."

In his keynote address, Mr. Ban lamented that "despite our ardent aspirations and various efforts... we have not been able to make a lasting breakthrough" on the peninsula. Noting the recent spate of missile tests by North Korea, he urged the UN to implement its enacted sanctions while taking steps to help North Korean leaders "return to the dialogue table."

Mr. Ban praised UPF and its Think Tank 2022 project as "quite meaningful"—they offer a "robust platform" that can be built on and lead to a significant breakthrough, he said. He also thanked Dr. Moon, saying she "has been sparing no efforts" to bring peace to the Korean Peninsula.

Finally, speaking from his own experiences living in a divided nation, Mr. Ban said he hoped that "one day in the near future," the people of the South can "directly engage with our brothers and sisters in the North." "If we work together with wisdom sincerity and resolve, I do believe we can illuminate the path to peace, both on the Korean Peninsula and beyond," he said.

"I have great trust in the word 'hope," said former Prime Minister of Japan Shinzo Abe, citing "trust and honesty" as crucial elements in discussions to advance peace in

In his remarks, US President Donald J. Trump (2017-2021) said that when he took office, the experts around him viewed the Korean situation as "absolutely hopeless. He said he rejected that outlook and instead worked with allies, Mr. Abe of Japan and South Korean President Moon Jae-in, to craft "a bold, new strategy" that led to him meeting three times with North Korean Chairman Kim Jong-un and becoming the first US president to stand on North Korean soil.

Together, "we have planted seeds of peace and cooperation, and now we must let them bloom and grow, just like a giant tree. To waste that chance would be a profound tragedy," Mr. Trump said. He added that countless people of goodwill around the world are "working, striving and praying for a Korea that is safe, prosperous, flourishing, united and finally at peace."

ections" are so important to building trust, said Hon. Mike Pompeo, US Secretary of State (2018-2021), who recalled some of the ups and downs of his diplomatic meetings with North Koreans in his remarks.

H.E. Jose Manuel Barroso, European Commission President (2004-2014), said he wed several "peace processes," including that of war-torn Angola. Although Angolan leaders were tempted to partition the nation, they found ways to work through their differences as one nation. Quoting Nelson Mandela, he added, "It always seems impossible until it's done.'

US Vice President **Mike Pence** (2017-2021) listed religious freedom; dignity and respect for all life, born and unborn; equal treatment under the law; education and strong families as essential elements of a stable, prosperous nation.

"Independence and self-determination" are also vital ingredients to a strong nation, said Cambodian Prime Minister Hun Sen. "Cambodia was also a victim of the Cold War and grand power politics, but positive engagement helped it find unity." The Korean people share a language, culture and common history, the prime minister added. "You cannot cut the Korean bloodline. People are like water—you cannot cut the water."

Many world leaders invoked faith in God to resolve humanity's crises.

"What is impossible for us is possible for God," said H.E. **Federico Franco**, president of Paraguay (2012-2013). "Prayer continues to be the best weapon we have for the return of peace in the Korean Peninsula ... and all of you in Seoul are not alone; in all the countries of the planet, we are praying for peace between the two Koreas."

"God calls to every human heart and we need to hear His calling," said Mr. Pompeo. The **World Summit 2022** and its efforts are surely creating "a divine opportunity" for God to act on the Korean Peninsula, said Pastor **Paula White-Cain**, head of the Paula White Ministries and spiritual adviser to Mr. Trump.

Others linked unification in Korea to peacebuilding elsewhere in the world. "If we can achieve peace in the Korean Peninsula, there will be hope that peace can be established worldwide, since the steps taken for peace in the Korean Peninsula can be imitated by other nations," said H.E. **Jimmy Morales**, Guatemala President (2016-2020).

"Korea can eventually become a shining example to the world of how peace can arise from conflict," said H.E. **Gloria Arroyo**, Philippines President (2001-2010). "A heavenly unified Korea is a prerequisite for a heavenly unified world," said Dr. **Yun Young-ho**, co-chair of the World Summit 2022 Executive Committee. Beeland Enterprises Chairman and world-renown investment expert **Jim Rogers** outlined an exciting future for the Asia-Pacific region, especially once Korea's 38th parallel no longer blocks travel and commerce.

Some 85 world leaders from 70 nations addressed the Summit in person or by video, and 11 Korean political and civic leaders from around South Korea offered their congratulations. Some 3,500 networks around the world broadcast all, or part of the Summit, organizers said.
